

Fruit, Citrus, & Nut Information

Apple - *Not self-fertile, needs a compatible pollinator*

Anna - red blushed yellow/green fruit; 200-300 chill hours; pollinates with Golden Dorsett

Golden Dorsett - yellow/green fruit ;250 chill hours; pollinates with Granny Smith & Anna

Granny Smith - tart green fruit; 400 chill hours; pollinates with Golden Dorsett

Ein Shemer - crisp, sweet fruit; 350 chill hours; pollinates with Anna & Golden Dorsett

Fuji - crisp, sweet sugary fruit; 350-400 chill hours; pollinated with Granny Smith & Red

Delicious

Mollies Delicious - **New Jan 2024** - Very Large red over yellow fruit, crisp, sweet-tart, 400-500 chill hours

Pink Lady - **New Jan 2024** - Medium pinkish red fruit, crisp, sweet tangy juicy, 400-600 chill hours

Red Delicious - red fruit; 700-800 chill hours; pollinates with Granny Smith

Winesap - **New Jan 2024** - Small to medium fruit, heirloom variety, sugary tartness, crisp, 700-800 chill hours

Avocado - *Type A flower with female bloom in AM, Type B flower with male bloom in AM*

Lila - medium size fruit; type A (Cold Tolerance to 30°)

Fantastic - medium to large fruit ;type A (Cold Tolerance to 28°)

Joey - purple skin, small sized fruit; type B (Cold Tolerance to 20°)

Super Hass - large sized fruit; type A (Cold Tolerance to 28°)

Banana - *self-fertile*

Chiquita - large bunches of sweet fruit; produce 15-18 months (Cold Tolerance to 32°)

Dwarf Cavendish - medium bunches of sweet fruit; 15-17 months (Cold Tolerance to 30°)

Blackberry - *self-fertile, floricanes are a summer producer while producing only on two year old growth, primocane is a fall producer while producing on first year growth, everbearing is both primocane and floricanes*

Apache - thornless, large fruit; floricanes

Freedom - thornless, extra large sweet fruit; primocane

Travellers - thornless, medium-large fruit; primocane

Triple Crown - thornless, large fruit; floricanes

Blueberry - *recommend two different varieties to have a larger fruit production*

Brightwell - medium sized berries; late spring to early summer season

Climax - high yield of fruit; early spring to late spring

Darrow - evergreen, late spring early summer

Elliot - vigorous native high bush 5-6' ; late summer season

Emerald - large, sweet fruit; January-February blooms

Premier - medium sized dark berries; early spring season

Primadonna - large fruit, early spring

Tifblue - medium dark berries; late summer

Cherry - Southern Cherry (Barbados) - crimson colored fruit, soft, juicy; *self-fertile* (Cold Tolerance to 28°)

Dragon Fruit - *self-fertile*

Fig - *self-fertile, desired multiple seasons in a year*

Celeste - light brown to purple, medium sized fruit; summer season

Brown Turkey - rust red to purple, medium sized fruit; late spring & again in late summer

Miss Figgy - dwarf tree, burgundy fruit; spring and fall

Grapes **New Jan. 2024 Grapes**

Concord - Seeded, blue, ripens late September; 100 chill hours

Lakemont - Seedless, white, ripens late August; 150 chill hours

Grapefruit - *self-fertile*

Chandler Red - large fruit, sweet juicy flesh; pick season late winter to early spring (Cold Tolerance to low 20°s)

Rio Red - dark pink flesh, sweet tart flavor; pick season late winter to early spring (Cold Tolerance to 28°)

Goji Berry - super fruit, reddish.orange fruit, *self-fertile*; spring to summer season

Key Lime - small flavorful fruit,*self-fertile*; late summer to late fall (Cold Tolerance to 30°)

Kiwi - are not self-fertile, female and male varieties are needed for pollination (Cold Tolerance to 20°)

Saanichton - fuzzy, large sweet fruit,female variety ; 200 chill hours

Chinensis Tomuri - male variety, does not bear fruit; low chill hours

Prolific - self-fertile, low chill hours

Lemon - *self-fertile*

Improved Meyer's - juicy, sweet fruit; fall and early spring (Cold Tolerance to 28°)

Pink Variegated - mild flavor, clear to pinkish juice; winter to early spring (Cold Tolerance to 28°)

Lime - *self-fertile*

Kieffer - small, oval to short pyriform, and has an irregularly bumpy rind, leaves are edible (Cold Tolerance to 28°)

Persian - small seedless juicy fruit; summer season (Cold Tolerance to 28°)

Loquat - tangy sweet fruit, self-fertile; fall to early winter season (Cold Tolerance to 10°)

Mandarin - *self-fertile*

Clementine - small seedless very sweet fruit; fall season (Cold Tolerance to 28°)

Page - sweet, cross between a tangelo and clementine mandarin (Cold Tolerance to 20°)

Ponkan - sweet, subtly tangy taste (Cold Tolerance to 28°)

Mayhaw - not *self-fertile*, small red fruit, fruit is used for jams and jellies; late spring season

*****Available Jan. 2024** Mulberry** - *Morus Alba* - sweet and tart fruit, *self-fertile*; summer to fall season

Muscadine - *self-fertile*

Dark - medium sized dark fruit, best grape; fall season

Green - medium sized bright green fruit, grape; fall season

Nectarine - *self-fertile*

Mayfire - clingstone yellow flesh, early summer season; 750-850 chill hours

Olive - *self-fertile*

Arbequina - small to medium fruit; fall season

Chemiali - small nutty flavor; fall season

Orange - *self-fertile*

Calamondin - sour, tangy fruit; winter to spring season (Cold Tolerance to 20°)

Hamlin Sweet - thin skin, few seeds, tangy fruit; fall to winter season (Cold Tolerance to 28°)

Moro Blood - red flesh, raspberry flavor; winter to spring season (Cold Tolerance to 28°)

Red Navel Cara, Cara - seedless, easy to peel, pink/red flesh, great flavor, cross between a Washington Navel & a Bahia Navel (Cold Tolerance to 25°)

Washington Navel - juicy, tender, seedless fruit; winter season (Cold Tolerance to 28°)

PawPaw - not *self-fertile*, large fruit with mango/banana/berries/pineapple flavor

Peach - *Self-fertile, however more varieties yields more production*

****NEW Jan. 2024**** Earligrande - Yellow semi-clingstone, ripens mid to late May; 275 chill hours

Floradawn - semi-clingstone, yellow flesh; 300 chill hours

Florida Crest - soft yellow flesh, semi-clingstone, ripens late May; 350 chill hours

****NEW Jan. 2024**** Florida King - Yellow clingstone, ripens late May; 350 chill hours

Florida Prince - semi-clingstone, yellow flesh; 150 chill hours

Gulfking - large fruit, yellow flesh, clingstone; 350-400 chill hours

****NEW Jan. 2024**** La Feliciano - Large yellow freestone, ripens Mid-June; 550 chill hours

Mid Pride - large soft flesh, freestone fruit; 250 chill hours

****New Jan. 2024**** Red Baron - Firm yellow freestone, ripens mid-July to mid-August; 250 chill hours

PECANS **Available January 2024 PECANS**

Pecan - *Some are self-fertile, while others need a second variety to produce fruit;*

Caddo - Regular producer with good yields, scab resistant. Protandrous

Elliott - Small, prolific nut of excellent quality. Scab resistant. Protogynous

Hardy Native - Grown from Papershell nuts. A native type and exceedingly hardy nut. Nut size varies

Jackson - Outstanding pecan in size, 60% meat. High scab resistance. Self-fertile, excellent pollinator

Pears **Available January 024* Pears**

Ayers - Yellow with a red blush, ripens mid-August; 600 chill hours

Hosui - Brown skin, juicy sweet, Self-Fertile, ripens late August; 400 chill hours

Kieffer - Crispy white, skin is yellow with a red blush, ripens October; 300 chill hours

Pineapple - Brown skin, pineapple flavor, ripens August; 400 chill hours

Persimmon - *Some are self-fertile, while others need a second variety to produce fruit;*

American varieties will not cross with Japanese varieties

Fuyu - firm flesh fruit, non-astringent, crisp to eat, Japanese variety, **SF**; 100 chill hours

Native Sweet - soft when well ripened, astringent when not ripe, American variety, **SF**; 100 chill hours

Tanenashi - yellow/orange flesh, astringent, Japanese variety, **SF**; 200 chill hours

Plum - *Self-fertile, however more varieties yields more production*

Au Rubrum - red flesh, sweet fruit, clingstone; 700 chill hours

Bruce - yellow/orange flesh, freestone, tart fruit; 500 chill hours

Byron Gold - golden/yellow flesh, crisp fruit ; 450 chill hours

Methley - purple/red flesh, clingstone; 150-250 chill hours

Morris - bright red flesh, crisp firm fruit; 650 chill hours

Ozark - yellow, juicy, tart, semi-free clingstone fruit; 700-800 chill hours

Pomegranate - *self-fertile* - Wonderful - medium/large fruit, slightly tart; early season (Cold Tolerance to 12°)

Quince - flavor of spice, *self-fertile*, apple/pear, fruit is cooked for jams/preserves; early winter

Raspberry - *self-fertile*

Caroline - large red fruit, thorns; fall season

Satsuma - *self-fertile*

Arctic Frost - easy to peel fruit, sweet, tart flavor; proven to 12 degrees (Cold Tolerance to 9°)

Tangelo -self-fertile

Orlando - flavor of tangerine crossed with grapefruit, tart, tangy, juicy fruit (Cold Tolerance to 20°)

Tangerine -self-fertile

Sunburst - thin rine, sweet orange flavor fruit (Cold Tolerance to 25°)
