From the warehouse, they will be distributed around the world, and as of a few months ago, now in the US where needed!

We are still looking for cotton and cotton/poly blend flat sheets for the backing of our quilts - please keep an eye out for them at garage sales, estate sales, and thrift shops. As always, donations of poly blankets, batting and embroidery floss are also welcome, as we use them for quilts, too.

If you'd like to come join us, we still meet from 9-2 every Tuesday at St. Paul's Welcome Hall. All are welcome - you don't have to be a member, and teens through great-grandparent age are welcome! Come for an hour or the whole day! Don't have time to meet during the day, but still want to help? You can take home supplies to work on at your leisure — we have bundles of quilt squares, as well as boxes of scrap fabrics that don't fit the 11" square size, but are still very useable for quilts.
