Purpose:

To recognize student achievement and support education in the visual arts.

Eligibility:

Applicants must be admitted to an accredited U.S. college or university for the upcoming year with the intention of maintaining full-time status for the entire year. Applicants must be pursuing an undergraduate degree in the visual arts.

The SCAN scholarship is available to graduating high school seniors who meet <u>one</u> of the following criteria:

- A student resident of Newtown
- A current student membership in SCAN for at least two years
- A parent having current membership in SCAN for at least two years

Application Materials Required:

- A completed application form
- An evaluation from an art teacher on school letterhead

Personal Interview:

Each student applicant will meet with a panel of SCAN members. During this interview, students will be asked to present 12 or more pieces of original artwork and be prepared to discuss them.

Range of awards: \$300 - \$1000
