Painting Composition with Karen Israel (all mediums)

Saturday, September, 24th: 10 AM to 4 PM Fees: \$80 (\$100 Non-members)

In this exciting one day workshop on composition, the artist will learn elements that are needed to create a dynamic composition. Through the use of handouts and a keynote presentation, the artist will develop a deeper understanding and the confidence to create design plans from their chosen photograph. Utilizing their own photographs, each artist will create 3 design sketches from their one chosen photo, employing the elements of design that were discussed. Then the artist will paint one of those 3 plans in this workshop. All levels and mediums are welcome. Karen will advise students as they work and if there is time, there will be a group discussion at the end of the day.

The Stages of a Successful Painting using Pastels with Jane Penfield

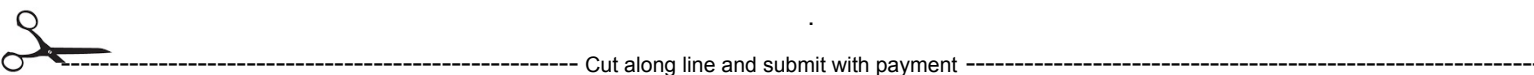
Saturday, October, 1st: 10 AM to 4 PM Fees: \$80 (\$100 Non-members)

During this full-day workshop we will learn a pastel underpainting technique to establish solid composition and values from the very beginning. Learn to approach your painting in stages, from shapes to details. Jane will demonstrate and teach strategies for planning your composition, understanding color and value, and successfully interpreting your reference photos.

Watercolor Painting with Sandra Cointreau

Saturday, October, 29th: 10 AM to 4 PM Fees: \$80 (\$100 Non-members)

Learn to paint in watercolor an interesting painting to be done in one day. A painting of a simple sky, water, trees and stones, and two very easy cranes. Sandra will provide outlines of the cranes for everyone to trace. Otherwise, no drawing skills needed. Please bring your own supplies, however, Sandra will provide paints and plastic palettes for those who need it for the day. For brushes: hake brushes (1" and 2") and a liner (Princeton No. 4 synthetic). All skill levels welcome.
