Minutes of the Board of Directors Meeting April 14, 2023

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Date: April 14, 2023 Time: 1:00 PM

1. Call to order, Roll Call, Establish Quorum: President Katy Banks called the Meeting to order at 1:00 p.m. Other Board members present were Mike Banks, Scott Chancellor, Paul Williamsen, Vince Bralic, and Jeff Cameron, establishing a quorum. Absent was Barb Wuehrmann. Also attending was Cadden Manager, Lori Wuollet and 11 homeowners.

Approve Agenda: A motion to modify the Agenda was made, seconded and unanimously approved to add an Executive Session following the Meeting.

- **2. Approve March Meeting Minutes:** A motion to "approve the minutes of the LCCA Board Meeting on March 10, 2023," was made, seconded, and unanimously approved.
- 3. Manager's Report: Lori Wuollet:
 - **A.** Reported on tasks completed and action items, and provided reports in the meeting packet for review.
- **4. Financial Report:** Mike Banks: As of March 31, 2023:

Mike reported that Bill Richards Electric determined we have 242 lights on Desert Bell, and we have replaced 125 of them. That leaves a balance of 117 lights to be replaced. The anticipated completion date is the end of 2024.

5. Committee Reports:

- **A. Landscape and Maintenance:** Scott Chancellor:
 - **1) Median Project:** Three medians remain to be upgraded by Points West, who has provided a proposal. The Landscape Committee will review and recommend by June.
 - **2) Repaint Monuments:** Seeking bids for repaint and re-stucco of all three monuments. Some iron work may also be needed at Esperanza. The Landscape Committee will review and recommend by June.
 - 3) **Erosion Issues:** Scott looking for a volunteer to handle erosion issues.
 - **4) Buffelgrass:** LCCA received a complaint from Pima County, but no buffelgrass was detected at reported location.

5) Weeds: The vendor hired to handle our weed problem on Desert Bell apologized for errors in spraying for weeds. The vendor is working with Scott to fix the problems.

B. Social Committee: Paul Williamsen

- 1) Paul presented a recap of the St Patrick's Social Dinner. Total expenses charged to LCCA were \$2,840.88.
- **2)** The next Bingo-type Social Event is contemplated for September or October, subject to Board approval.
- 3) As approved in the March Board Meeting, "the Social Committee will pay for its own consumables in future events, and LCCA will pay for other costs such as promotions."

6. Old Business:

- A. Reserve Study: The ad hoc Reserve Study Committee received proposals from two companies: Advanced Research Solutions (ARS) and Reserve Data Analysis (RDA). Mike recapped the two proposals as evaluated by the Committee. A motion was made "to accept the ARS Option 1 proposal for \$950." The motion was seconded and unanimously approved. Additionally, drainage issues within LCCA were briefly discussed and will be addressed in the study by ARS and LCCA.

- 9. Non-Board Member Comments:
 - **A.** Buffelgrass in the Esperanza property may need mitigation in the future.

 - **D.** Many complaints and concerns were expressed by property owners in the Solterra tract.
