Academic Integrity and Code of Conduct Policy for Student-Athletes

At the Sports Academy of Wellington, student-athletes are held to the highest standards of integrity, accountability, and sportsmanship, both in the classroom and on the field. Enrollment in our program is a privilege that carries the responsibility of representing the Academy with honor, respect, and discipline.

1. Academic Integrity and Accountability

Student-athletes are expected to:

Demonstrate honesty in all academic work. Cheating, plagiarism, or misrepresentation of work will not be tolerated.

Take ownership of their academic progress and meet all expectations set forth by instructors and coaches.

Remain on target academically, complete assignments on time, and seek support when needed.

Uphold the Academy's commitment to learning by modeling diligence, effort, and consistency.

2. Coachability and Sportsmanship

Athletes are expected to be coachable, meaning they:

Accept constructive feedback with a positive attitude.

Show respect toward coaches, staff, teammates, and opponents at all times.

Take direction and demonstrate accountability for both their performance and conduct.

Represent the Academy with humility and teamwork, placing collective goals above individual recognition.

3. Behavior and Conduct Expectations

The Sports Academy of Wellington maintains a zero-tolerance policy for misconduct that undermines our values or the safety of our community.

Bullying, harassment, or intimidation of any kind is strictly prohibited.

Profanity, inappropriate language, or gestures will not be accepted in school, during practices, or at games.

Possession or use of contraband, including drugs, alcohol, tobacco, or vaping products, is strictly forbidden on school property or during any Academy-related activity.

4. Disciplinary Action

Any credible incident or violation of this policy will result in immediate disciplinary action, which may include:

Suspension from school and/or athletic participation.

Revocation of privileges or leadership roles.

Referral to administration for further review and consequences up to dismissal.
