- 2. Applications will be made available to applicants on June 11th, 2023 and must be submitted to the Scholarship Committee for consideration by June 30th, 2023.
- Applicants for consideration are limited to undergraduate degrees or educational
 institutions such as trade schools or community colleges offering certificate degrees.
 The only exception to these guidelines is for applicants attending Seminary / Lay Pastor
 Training.
- 4. All applicants must reapply each year for this annual scholarship.
- 5. All applicants must complete a short paragraph detailing the reasons why they chose their particular area of study. (3-5 sentences/short)
- Once scholarship applications have been reviewed and applicants approved by Session, scholarships will be awarded and made payable to qualified individuals. Scholarship funds will then be distributed on either August 6th or August 13th, 2023.
- 7. Each individual receiving scholarship funds is required to attend Polk Presbyterian Church on the day funds are distributed to thank the congregation and speak about their educational goals and plans for the future.
