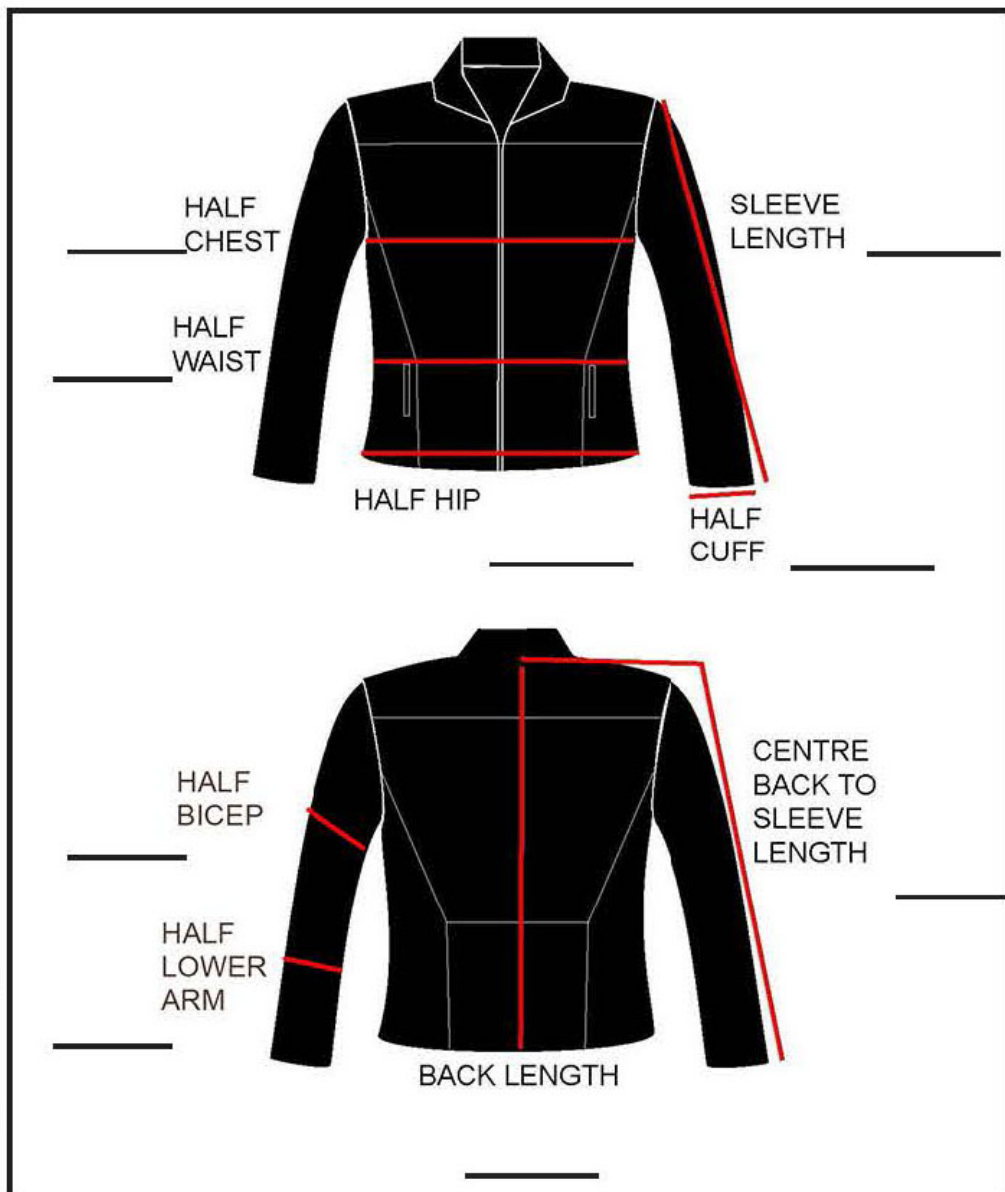


Fitting Method 2 - Garment Measurement Form

Use the measurements of a garment that fits you well from your own closet and use the Leather Finished Garment Measurement Chart below to determine the size to order. When using this method you simply find a garment in your closet that fits you well and has a style similar to the garment you are ordering (ex. a fitted jacket if you are ordering a fitted jacket). Lay the garment flat and measure it from side to side in the areas indicated on the diagram above. Since the garment is flat, you must double the number for the measurements indicating circumference to get the total number of inches. For lengths (jacket length, sleeve length) you don't have to double it. Order the garment size that most closely matches the measurements of the garment from your closet. Color chart is also included below.

These measurements apply to our standard leather skirts, pants and our semi-fitted jacket.
