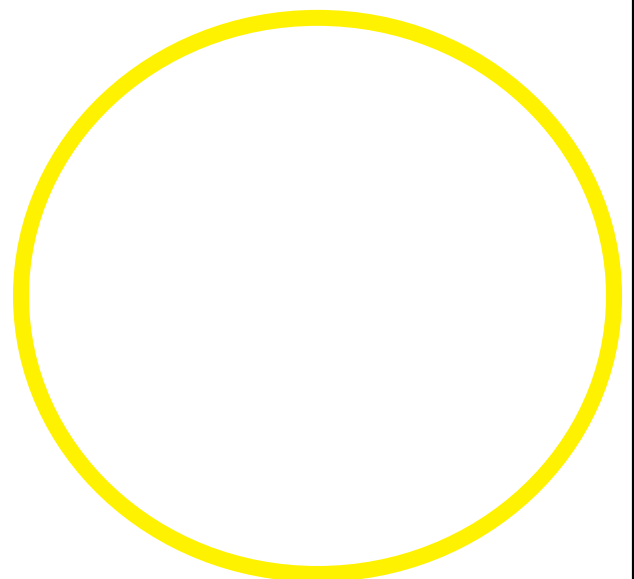

Expressions of HOPE

Reflections on the Words of Life

By Pastor Paul Ferrie, Grace Reformed Church of the Lord Jesus, New Leipzig

We have been considering the plot which Daniel's enemies devised to get him out of their way. We saw that by playing on King Darius's pride, they convinced him to sign a decree which for thirty days prohibited all in the empire from praying to anyone except Darius.

An essential part of their scheme depended upon Daniel's continuing what had been his practice all along. They were counting on him to keep praying to his God, and we find in Daniel 6:10 that he did not disappoint: "Now when Daniel knew that the writing was signed, he went home. And in his upper room, with his windows open toward Jerusalem, he knelt down on his knees three times that day, and prayed and gave thanks before his God, as was his custom since early days."

Some might say that this was misplaced zeal on Daniel's part. He could have just kept

his praying to himself. After all, Jesus said in Matthew 6:6, "But you, when you pray, go into your room, and when you have shut your door, pray to your Father who is in the secret place; and your Father who sees in secret will reward you openly."

In answer to this, we must understand that Daniel's praying before his open window had nothing to do with ostentation. Daniel never intended to draw attention to himself, but neither did he try to hide the fact that he was a praying man. He would not now attempt to hide something he had always done by way of devotion to God. The purpose, we are told, was that he might face toward Jerusalem. Let us remember that Daniel was in a foreign land, having been taken away from Jerusalem and the place where the temple of God's worship had once stood. He was a captive and was longing for the day when his people would return to Jerusalem. We are told later in the book of Daniel that he had been reading the prophecy of Jeremiah that the captivity would come to an end after seventy years. That time was now rapidly approaching. Thus, for Daniel to pray facing Jerusalem was a way of stirring up his own faith in God's promise.

Furthermore, when the temple in Jerusalem was built centuries before, King Solomon prayed this prayer for God's people who might in the future be taken into captivity: "And when they return to You with all their heart and with all their soul

in the land of their enemies who led them away captive, and pray to You toward their land which You gave to their fathers, the city which I have built for Your name: then hear in heaven Your dwelling place their prayer and their supplication, and maintain their cause" (1 Kings 8:48-49). By praying toward Jerusalem, Daniel was heeding the instructions and promises of God's Word. He was proclaiming that his citizenship and ultimate loyalties were with God's Kingdom.

Friends, being able to go before the King of the universe and present our petitions at His throne of grace is an unspeakable privilege. But it is vital to remember that there is

only one way of approaching God, and that is through Jesus Christ. Daniel approached God through the Christ who was to come, and we may approach Him through the Christ who has come. Jesus said in John 14:6, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me." Paul wrote in 1 Timothy 2:5, "For there is one God and one Mediator between God and men, the Man Christ Jesus." Therefore, praying to any other god or seeking to come to the true God in any other way will do no good. This is not a popular message in our day of inclusivism, nor has it ever been a popular message. But it is vital, and I pray that each of you has come savingly to God through Jesus Christ.

Cloud Seeding Operations Summary for August 8-14, 2022
 BISMARCK, N.D. - Scattered rain showers and isolated thunderstorms made a reappearance in southwestern North Dakota late last week. However, most locations only received between a trace and a tenth of an inch of rain. There were five operational flights between August 11-14 for either hail suppression, rain enhancement, or reconnaissance flown in the Bowman and Slope County project area.

A slow-moving low-pressure system will exit southwestern North Dakota at the beginning of this week bringing scattered showers and thunderstorms to the area. Warm, dry conditions favorable for harvest should set in for the remainder of the week as North Dakota resides underneath the leading edge of an entrenched upper-level ridge of high pressure.

Radar facilities in Bowman operate around the clock during the NDCMP. Radar images can be viewed on the Atmospheric Resource Board's web site at www.dwr.nd.gov/arb.

Participation in the NDCMP was determined through a county-level public process. District 1 is comprised of Bowman County and seven townships in Slope County. The NDCMP will continue through the end of August.

"Our Great Plains- Mourning Doves"

"Good Morning - Mourning Doves", a polite 'n' friendly greeting that I subconsciously say nearly every morning to "Our Great Plains- Mourning Doves" when I hear their ah-oooh! whooo-whooh-whooh cooing. Believe me, I don't confuse the mourning dove's call with an owl's hooting.

'Mourning Doves' are classified as migratory birds and are regulated by the Migratory Bird Treaty Act (MBTA) of 1918 (Canada and Mexico included) which prohibits the take (including killing, capturing, selling, trading, and transport) of protected migratory bird species without prior authorization by the Department of Interior U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service. However, the 'Mourning Dove' is the most hunted migratory game bird in North America. The U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service has studied and regulated 'Mourning Doves' for nearly 50 years now,

and data has shown that a hunting season on them has virtually no impact on their population. The 'Mourning Dove' is one of the most abundant birds in the United States, with an estimated fall population of 500 million birds. Note: In 2022, North Dakota's dove season opens September 1 and closes November 29th, but doves will migrate south (mostly by day, in flocks) when the weather turns cold so usually the best dove hunting is during the first week of September.

It's said that adult 'Mourning Doves' (10 to 13 inches long with spotted wings; muted colors from brown to grayish-brown, to gray; weighing between 4 to 6 pounds) are monogamous for at least the breeding season and possibly for multiple breeding seasons. It also has been documented that they often will return to the same breeding location and even use the same

nest in successive years. Male 'Mourning Doves' acquire nest material for the female to construct the nest (usually rather flimsy) after they've paired up for breeding. 'Mourning Doves' often nest along the edges of roadsides, woodlands, rangelands, and croplands. They nest on the ground, and in trees usually after the trees have leafed out completely.

'Mourning Doves' breed prolifically, producing (2) white eggs per brood and raising up to five or six broods per year, more than any other native bird. Egg incubating is done by both parents, for about 14 days. Both the 'Mourning Dove' parents produce "crop milk," an antioxi-

dant-rich liquid secreted in their throats. The milk is also high in fat and protein. The two bird youngsters are fed this milky substance while they are still in the nest. Eventually as adults- their diet transitions to seeds (99% of their diet) from plants such as field grasses, corn, sorghum, wheat (and other cultivated grains), annual sunflowers, and ragweed. Occasionally they will eat small Faucet Snails (up to about 1/2 inch in length) and also the Mud Snail (up to 1/8 inch in length). Very rarely will adult 'Mourning Doves' eat any insects. A Mourning Dove's brood starts with (2) eggs, then hatchlings, and they grow into two young chicks which leave the nest around 15 days later, usually waiting nearby to be fed for the next 1 to 2 weeks. Their leaving the nest is because another brood is planned to follow almost immediately.

The cooing of "Our Great Plains- Mourning Doves" is one of America's most familiar bird sounds (cooOoo-woo-o), and they're one of the most common birds around the countryside too. When launching upward and landing, their wings produce a distinct whistling sound; they are noisy flyers. They are also fast flyers - cruising at 55 mph after climbing and leveling off in their migrating flight.

'Mourning Doves' (along with their White Dove Cousins) symbolize - hold a special place in folklore and mythology; it's been said that they encourage emotional healing, forgiveness, and even aid in building friendships (past or New)- all of which: can move "Us" forward into Spiritual Peace, Love, and Faith. Noah released a dove from his ark, and when the bird returned with an olive branch, he knew the land was near.

To the Native Americans, the 'Mourning Dove' represents spirit and communication with the spirit. They believe that when the 'Mourning Dove' appears, there will be opportunities and messages for growth.



RECIPE OF THE DAY

SAUCE FOR BARBECUED CHICKEN

- 1 C. catsup
 - 1/4 C. lemon juice
 - 1/4 C. brown sugar
 - 2 T. oleo
 - 1 T. horseradish, opt.
 - 1/4 tsp. oregano
 - 1/4 tsp. thyme
 - 1 tsp. grated onion
 - 1 tsp. dry mustard
 - 1 crushed garlic clove
 - 2 T. Worcestershire sauce
 - Salt and pepper, to taste
 - 1/4 tsp. marjoram
- Simmer for 10 minutes. Dip chicken pieces in sauce. Lay on foil on cookie sheet to bake at 350° for 1 1/2 to 2 hours or done. Baste chicken every 30 minutes.

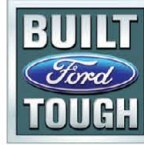
