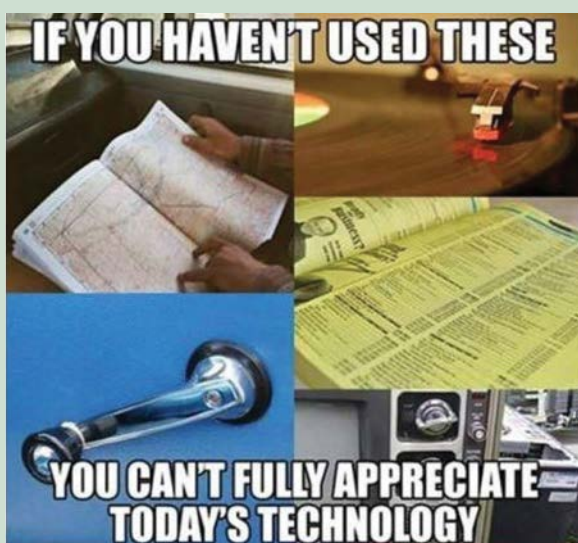
We have those someones in our communities - open your hearts - seek them out and go to Hopessville. You'll be glad you did.

### Bowman Community Chorus Distributes Funds

At a recent meeting of the Bowman Community Chorus Community Chorus Scholarship and Steering Committee,

funds from the 2021 Christmas Concert were distributed to local entities. Very generous donations from many area businesses and sales of DVDs of the concert made this possible this year. During it's 63 plus years of Christmas Concerts and various other performances, the Chorus has always had great support and it is with so much gratitude that the Chorus is able to fund musical activities in our area!

The Chorus has always welcomed high school students from the three area schools. To support their music program, the chorus has given Bowman County High School, Scranton High School and Harding County High School music departments funding that they can use for music camp scholarships or whatever the needs they have to keep their departments going strong.

The Chorus also gave to the Bowman Lutheran Church for allowing the Chorus to perform there for so many years. The Bowman High School Dollars for Scholars also received funding.

The Bowman Community Chorus has a Music Scholarship available to graduates of Bowman County High School, Scranton High School and Harding County High School who are entering at least their sophomore year of college and enrolled in performing arts or music education programs. Applicants should have a history of musical performance and community volunteerism. This scholarship is offered annually and can be up to \$500 if funding is available. It is a onetime award and the chorus has been proud to award it to three area students in the past years. Guidance Counselors in the three area schools have information and how to apply for it. Applicants must be filled out and returned by May 1<sup>st</sup> of the current year.

### Reflections on the Words of Life

When the apostles Peter and John were imprisoned and told by the Jewish authorities that they must never again preach in the name of Jesus Christ, they replied, "We ought to obey God rather than men" (Acts 5:29). As we continue our study in the book of Daniel, we come to a portion of Scripture which wonderfully illustrates this response.

Last time we saw that Nebuchadnezzar had a ninety-foot tall golden image set up and required all the people in his kingdom to bow down and worship it or be cast into a fiery furnace. So when the music played with great fanfare, all the leaders of the Babylonian Empire together with all the common people present bowed down and worshiped. That is, all but three men. Three young Jewish men, Hananiah, Mishael, and Azariah—who had been renamed Shadrach, Meshach, and Abed-nego—refused to bow.

It is interesting to see who comes forth to accuse these men. We read in Daniel 3:8, "Therefore at that time certain Chaldeans came forward and accused the Jews." The word "Chaldeans" in the previous chapter referred to one of the categories of wise men in Babylon whose lives had been saved by the prayers and actions of Daniel, Hananiah, Mishael, and Azariah in the matter of King Nebuchadnezzar's dream. (Note: Daniel was most likely in a different part of the empire when the events of chapter 3 occurred.) Perhaps we can sense a hint of jealousy in the words of the

Chaldeans: "There are certain Jews whom you have set over the affairs of the province of Babylon: Shadrach, Meshach, and Abed-Nego; these men, O king, have not paid due regard to you. They do not serve your gods or worship the gold image which you have set up" (Daniel 3:12).

Not surprisingly, the megalomaniac king reacted to this accusation with rage. Verse 13 tells us, "Then Nebuchadnezzar, in rage and fury, gave the command to bring Shadrach, Meshach, and Abed-Nego. So they brought these men before the king." What is rather surprising is that the king actually gave these men another chance to comply with his demand. Yet his apparent exercise of patience included a severe warning: "But if you do not worship, you shall be cast immediately into the midst of a burning fiery furnace. And who is the god who will deliver you from my hands?" (Daniel 3:15). Next time, Lord willing, we shall see the response of the Hebrew men.

Friends, there is an important lesson here. We see, both in the Chaldeans who reported the three Hebrews and in Nebuchadnezzar himself, a picture of the unbelieving world which is very anxious to persuade Christians to conform to its standards and practices. We also see that the world finds lack of conformity by the people of God intolerable. This is why in many countries right now, Christians are being arrested, tortured, and sometimes killed because they refuse to renounce their allegiance to Christ. How can they endure such treatment? They know that Jesus suffered the excruciating pains of the cross to pay the debt of their sins. They know that He prom-

ises to be with them and sustain them in whatever they may be called to suffer. They know that the forgiveness and eternal life which Christ promises are far above the worth of anything the world could offer them. As the apostle Paul expressed it, "Our light affliction, which is but for a moment, is working for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory" (2 Corinthians 4:17). Friend, have you seen that what Jesus did on the cross to save His people from their sins is what you need? Have you seen that your eternal destiny depends on whether you have placed your trust in Him alone for salvation? May God give us eyes to see that Jesus is the pearl of great price, indispensable to our eternal happiness. And may He give us the courage of the three Hebrews to remain loyal to Him no matter what.

Jesus says in John 14:15-17 "If you love me, you will keep my commandments. And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Helper, to be with you forever, even the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees him nor knows him. West River Health Services

Foundation raises \$216,227 through Giving Hearts Day

The West River Health Services Foundation (WRHSF) recently participated in its fourth year of Giving Hearts Day, a state-wide charity event and platform that helps nonprofits like West Riv-

er Health Services (WRHS) raise funds both locally and abroad. This year the foundation raised a total of \$216,227 through 464 individual community donations and \$80,000 of matching funds from local businesses.

The foundation was also recently awarded an additional \$2,000 from Giving Hearts Day partners for placing in the top five for most raised within their non-profit category: (\$250,000 - \$1 million operating expense).

"Together, we raised \$56,000 more than our goal of \$160,000," said WRHS Foundation Officer Ted Uecker. "We are grateful and thankful; we think it is a terrific amount of money raised."

Support from this year's Giving Hearts Day donations, Uecker said, has kick-started the Foundation's goal of raising \$500,000 in 5 years for the foundation's new "Healthcare Heroes Endowment Fund." The new fund will bolster hiring efforts for ancillary and support staff at West River Health Services and Western Horizons Assisted Living and Care Center.

"We are currently at \$182,200 raised for our Healthcare Heroes Endowment Fund," said Uecker. "Not all of the Giving Hearts Day gifts went to the Healthcare Heroes fund – some went towards scholarships, the ambulance, or the care center. People have different things they want to support, but we recommended that people give to the Healthcare Heroes Fund because we have been so short-handed for staffing at West River and Western Horizons."

Uecker said the foundation will use any interest generated from the new fund to attract new workers through sign-on bonuses, internal bonuses, and an academic loan program.

"In the past we were giving out scholarships, but they weren't turning into jobs at West River Health Services, so we are going to start an academic loan program," said Uecker.

The academic loan program will provide students and newly graduated healthcare workers a \$10,000 forgivable student loan contingent upon an application at either West River Health Services or Western Horizons. The loan

and interest is then forgiven over the course of two years of work at either organization.

"In this new program, if students accept the \$10,000 loan, they sign on the dotted line that they will apply for a job here after they get their degree," said Uecker. "We want these students to have skin in the game and commit to working here."

Due to the pandemic, WRHSF was unable to host their usual Giving Hearts Day themed events. Even still, Uecker said the strong support from local area communities, businesses, volunteers and employees has already reduced the foundation's fundraising goal timeline for the new fund, from \$500,000 in 5 years to \$500,000 in 3 years.

"We thought Giving Hearts Day was just a terrific day," said Uecker.

"Kim Schalesky put in a ton of effort to scan checks to the Dakota Medical Foundation... We even had Dr. John Kludt and Gale Holfand volunteer their time to call people on Giving Hearts Day who made gifts, which we thought was sensational."

Uecker said the foundation was "ecstatic" to hear that they were awarded \$2,000 from the Impact Foundation for placing in the top five in their nonprofit category: (\$250,000 - \$1 million operating expense) for total funds raised.

"This is the first time in three years that we have cracked the top 5, and we think it is terrific news," said Uecker. "If we continue this momentum, it's possible that we could be awarded up to \$10,000 in future Giving Hearts Day efforts."

Looking forward, Uecker said the hospital is still eligible to receive more awards from the Giving Hearts Day platform this year. Additional funds could be awarded to the West River Health Services Foundation for achieving various milestones, including most gifts received, repeat donors, and more.

"We hope to hear more in the coming weeks," said Uecker. "Thank you to all who participated in this year's Giving Hearts Day."

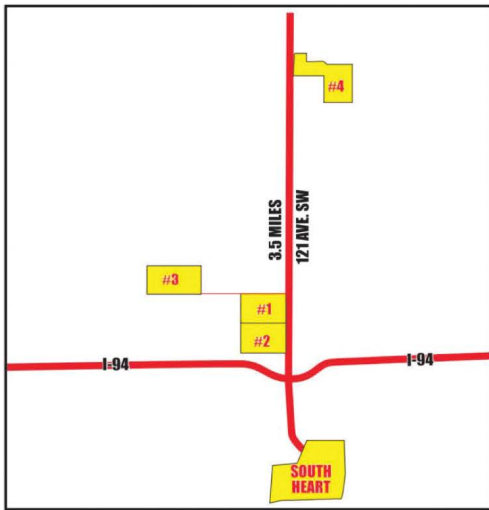



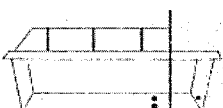

Often Gnomes (some installed with cameras) are doing surveillance duties tucked into the rafters of a barn, around outbuildings, or on fence posts watching over livestock and field crops. Farmers believe that Gnomes are good luck charms and can help their fields yield more production and protect their animals & family from thieves, pests, and other problems. I’ve been told that inside some households, Gnomes have replaced the ‘Elf on the Shelf.’ I have even noticed Gnome-Angels in sewing rooms.

Garden Gnomes were originally placed as yard decorations for ‘Wealthy Europeans’, but now are prevalent in gardens and lawns throughout the Western World, proudly standing as mini statues between one and two feet high (some are larger). Garden Gnomes have grown in popularity throughout the 19th and 20th Centuries, and still Today 2022 (MMXXII), they welcome the 21 Century.

Garden Gnomes are ‘Loved in Folklore’ in many different countries worldwide; including Spain, Denmark, England, and Norway just to name a few. Throughout the world, Garden Gnomes have the same general look. Male Gnomes usually have a long-white beard, usually a red hat (but not always), and they wear simple clothes. Female Gnomes tend to have “Beautiful Long Hair”, some kind of a fashionable hat, and plain-looking clothes. Garden Gnomes can be found in all sorts of different costumes and added accessories; some with kegs of beer, built-in solar lighting, skiing gnomes, gnomes taking baths, and gnomes mooning onlookers, and there are many more selections, sizes, and poses to choose from. How about fishing or napping gnomes... lighthearted biker or barbecuing gnomes. If Gnomes give you a laugh they are serving their purpose and doing your heart & soul good!

Two closing questions: “Are you Gnome Alone?”, and- “Are you Gnomeotized yet?”

Final Thought... \*Bigger is not always better; ‘Little Garden Gnomes’ are often more interesting & friendlier than \*Giants.

A Little Birdie Told Me: "What's With a Winter Storm Named "Nancy"?" I checked the weather report on Sunday and Winter Storm Nancy was to bring 5-10 inches of snow with wind chills around -35. A winter storm warning was issued for the winter storm named "Nan-

cyl!" To my way of thinking a real blizzard should be named "Goliath" or "Darth Vader!" But "Nancy" Let's get real: Naming the storm "Nancy" probably took all the punch right out of the storm. Back in the day (I can say that now since I'm almost 60!) a blizzard came without warning. We prayed for snow days and if we were blessed with a real blizzard it meant days off from school. A blizzard could last a week with 2-3 feet of heavy wet snow, the drifts would change size and shape several times: Now that's a storm to name, "Goliath." I remember my Dad telling us of a winter with temperatures at -20 for 30 days in a row. He wasn't talking about wind chill, "We didn't have wind

chill back then it was just "Damn Cold!" I remember a blizzard in the 70's we had the cows in the yard down in a hole with snow all around. My brother and I would go out to hand pump water for the cows. The wind blew the water all around and our pants and boots would be solid ice. After a week we were out of propane, no electricity and no phone. Dad walked to the neighbor to get propane brought out. Some years we'd miss so much school, days would have to be made up, for kids attending Public School. We went to St. Mary's, a boarding school, so the boards still had school so no days for us to make up! When our kids were in school we had a

real blizzard once again no electricity. The hospital was right across the street so we made soup on our camp stove for the staff. Elderly were brought in on snowmobiles since the hospital had a generator. Hospital and nursing home staff were picked up by snowmobile to get to and from work. Now that's no storm named "Nancy" that's definitely a "Darth Vader!" I worked in Mott in the mid 80's and the week after Easter we had a spring blizzard. I tried to go to work but went in the ditch twice in the first mile. I turned around and went home. My sister and I decided we'd better check the sewer vent. I tried to lift her onto my shoulders so she could get on the roof. It was epic we both fell into a snow bank and we laughed until we cried, I think I may have peed my pants! That storm should have been named "Cruella Deville!" A Little Birdie Told Me: "A Storm by its Very Nature Needs a Name With Some PUNCH!"

RECIPE OF THE DAY

BAKED FRIED CHICKEN

1 large boneless, skinless chicken breasts  
3 cups buttermilk  
1 cup all purpose flour  
1 tablespoon paprika  
1 tablespoon all purpose seasoning  
1 teaspoon salt  
1 teaspoon black pepper  
1/2 stick butter, melted  
1/4 cup fresh flat leaf parsley, optional

Cut chicken breasts in half, lengthwise, to create 4 even portions. Place chicken in a large bowl and marinate in milk for about 20 minutes. Mix together flour, paprika, all-purpose spice, salt and pepper in a medium sized bowl. Set aside. Preheat oven to 400°F. Place parchment paper on a 9x13 baking sheet. Melt butter and pour onto the parchment, coating the bottom of the pan-parchment. Lightly pat each chicken breast with a paper towel to remove excess milk before dipping. Dip each chicken breast, one at a time, in the flour mixture. Coat both sides liberally. Place in pan. Repeat with all four chicken breasts, making sure there is a small amount of room between each breast in the pan. This will allow them to crisp while baking. Bake at 400°F for 35-40 minutes (or until the breading is golden brown and the juices run clear), flipping each breast after 20 minutes. Remove from oven and transfer to a serving dish. Garnish with parsley if desired. Enjoy!

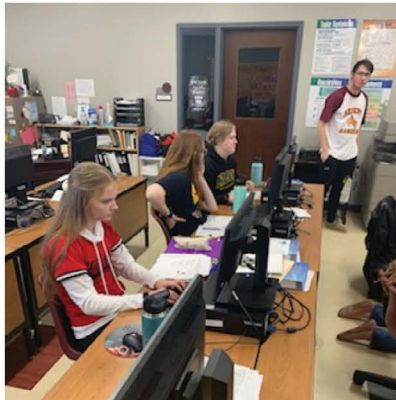
