already at birth.”

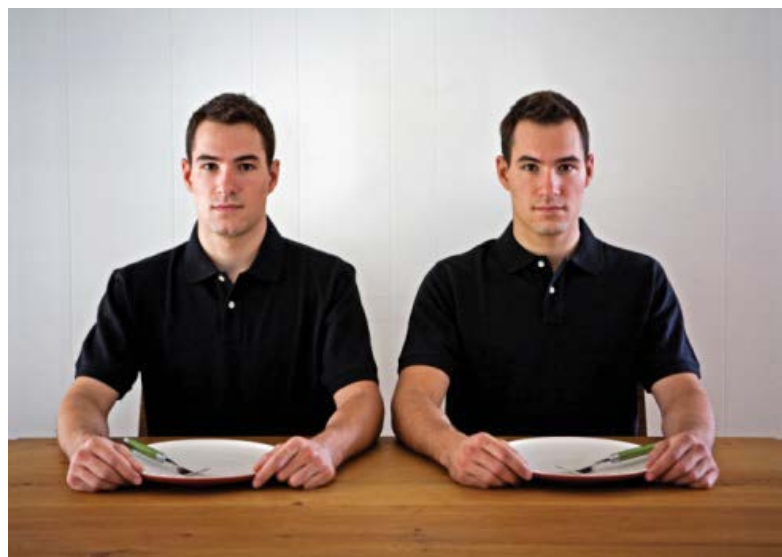
After much talking, thinking,



Reflections on the Words of Life

Last time we considered the progressive nature of sin, demonstrated by Babylon's King Belshazzar. We saw that his drunkenness led to blasphemy against God, when he ordered the holy vessels from God's temple to be brought to his feast. But there is yet another step in Belshazzar's wicked digression in sin, which we find in Daniel 5:4: "They drank wine, and praised the gods of gold and silver, bronze and iron, wood and stone." Belshazzar moved from drunkenness to blasphemy, and now to gross idolatry. He is an example of what Paul describes in Romans 1:28: "And even as they did not like to retain God in their knowledge, God gave

them over to a debased mind, to do those things which are not fitting." Belshazzar now leads his fellow-partiers in idolatry, praising just about anything he could think to praise, except the one true God.

But when we come to verse 5, we find that the party is suddenly crashed: "In the same hour the fingers of a man's hand appeared and wrote opposite the lampstand on the plaster of the wall of the king's palace; and the king saw the part of the hand that wrote." God has had enough. His long-suffering has reached its end. Not surprisingly, Belshazzar's tune changed radically. We read in Daniel 5:6, "Then the king's countenance changed, and his thoughts troubled him, so that the joints of his hips were loosened and his knees knocked against each other."

Belshazzar is no longer the

proud and flippant blasphemer he was just a moment ago. He is uncontrollably shaking with fear. But why? He does not know what the writing says. It could have been a message of victory for his kingdom. Why is he so frightened? The answer is right here in the verse: his thoughts troubled him. It was Belshazzar's own guilty conscience which he had repeatedly violated that made him expect no good news from heaven. Even though he could not read the handwriting, he knew it was judgment from God.

Dear friends, see how God can make the heart of the boldest sinner tremble. And all He has to do is to let a person's own thoughts, his own guilty conscience, do the job. Numbers 32:23 says, "And be sure your sin will find you out."

Sadly, fear is all there was in Belshazzar's reaction. There is not a drop of genuine sorrow for sin. He takes the only course he knows. We read in verse 7, "The king cried aloud to bring in the astrologers, the Chaldeans, and the soothsayers. The king spoke, saying to the wise men of Babylon, 'Whoever reads this writing, and tells me its interpretation, shall be clothed with purple and have a chain of gold around his neck; and he shall be the third ruler in the kingdom.'" Like his grandfather before him, Belshazzar seeks for answers in all the wrong places.

Lord willing, we shall see more about Belshazzar next time. In closing, let us consider the tragedy of continually ignoring the warnings of the conscience. The conscience is a gift from God, but the Bible tells us that it can be so violated as to become "seared" (1 Timothy 4:1-2). Let us ask God to give us tender consciences that will be informed and guided by His Word. When we sin, may we be quick to repent and to seek forgiveness through the only means which God has provided: Christ's perfect payment for the sins of His people on the cross.

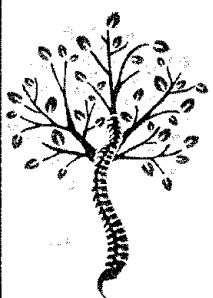





**Orphans and Widows**

As we prepare for what could be a change in how our country handles the issue of abortion, although not necessarily as big of a change as some want or some fear, it is vital for Christians and those who care about human life and those who are hurting and oppressed

that we remember how much Jesus cares greatly about widows and orphans and everyone who is lonely and without family. It is at the very heart of the Gospel. James 1:27 says, "Religion that God our Father accepts as pure and faultless is this: to look after orphans and widows in their distress and to keep oneself from being polluted by the world". It is not just our job to pray, but to act when we have the power to act. Being pro-life is not just a political slogan: and it certainly does not end when a baby is born. Being pro-life, pro-widow, pro-orphan, is a call to live out the Gospel for all of us who say we follow Jesus. Each of us are not able to meet every need, but we can attempt to meet the needs we are able to meet. There is also the continued need for us to continue reaching out to those who are lonely. Not just the widows and orphans, but also those who live alone, do not have family nearby, and even those we find difficult at times. The church, and each of us as individuals who make up the church, have a calling inherent within the Gospel to help people know what it means to have a family. As followers of Jesus, our family gets bigger, not smaller! Psalm 68:5-6 says that God is "A father to the fatherless, a defender of widows, is God in his holy dwelling. God sets the lonely in families, he leads forth the prisoners with singing; but the rebellious live in a sun-scorched land". Jesus invites us to invite all to be a part of His family and our family, though not all will accept. I challenge each of us that we will continue to be known as both a community and as individual congregations as being a place where you become family. I am so thankful Jesus accepted me and that others have accepted me as part of their families and as part of the family of God. Let us continually look for ways to be pro-life and pro-family in every avenue of our relationships. Jesus did not turn the broken, hurting, and angry, away, and neither should we.



Summary For
June 20-26, 2022**
BISMARCK, N.D. – Thunderstorms brought beneficial rains to southwestern North Dakota at the beginning of last week. Most locations received at least a half inch of rain. Temperatures continued to vary between noticeably below and above normal because of a progressive June trough/ridge weather pattern. Slope County townships decided to resume rain enhancement once again on June 20.

In the District 1 operations area, which includes Bowman and part of Slope Counties, aircraft conducted four operational flights last week for hail suppression, rain enhancement and repositioning purposes on June 20.

This week a couple of weather disturbances during the mid-week and into next weekend should bring a slight chance for thunderstorms to southwestern North Dakota. The alternating upper-level pattern of troughs and ridges continues, although temperatures should remain closer to average with the exception of a brief midweek cooldown.

Radar facilities in Bowman operate around the clock during the NDCMP. Radar images can be viewed on the Atmospheric Resource Board's web site at <http://www.swc.nd.gov/arb>. The NDCMP will continue through the end of August.





A Little Birdie Told Me: “Buffalo, South Dakota Proudly Displays its History at the Centennial Park and Buffalo Museum.” The Centennial Park features about 20 large placards with history of the area. The beautifully maintained park is located on Highway 85 at the south end of town. RECIPE OF THE DAY
RHUBARB BREAD

1-1/3 cups packed brown sugar
2/3 cup vegetable oil
1 large egg, room temperature, beaten
1 teaspoon vanilla extract
1 cup buttermilk
2-1/2 cups all-purpose flour
3/4 teaspoon salt
1/2 teaspoon ground cinnamon
1 teaspoon baking soda
1-1/2 to 2 cups finely diced rhubarb, 1/4-inch cuts
1/2 cup chopped nuts

In a bowl, combine the sugar and oil; blend in egg, vanilla and milk. Combine flour, salt, cinnamon and baking soda; add to moist ingredients. Stir in rhubarb and nuts. Bake 350° until a toothpick inserted in the center comes out clean, about 45 minutes. Cool for 10 minutes before removing from pans to wire racks.


