





fellowship hall. Our number one priority is to repair the church and then, if possible, the fellowship hall.

Reflections on the Words of Life

by Pastor Paul Ferrie, Grace Reformed Church of the Lord Jesus, New Leipzig

In our study of the book of Jonah, we are in the middle of the prayer which Jonah addressed to God in desperation from the belly of the great fish. Resuming today in Jonah 2:7, we read, "When my soul fainted within me, I remembered the LORD; and my prayer went up You into Your holy temple. Though Jonah was still conscious, he supposed he could not live much longer. His soul was fainting within him. Yet he remembered the LORD, and his prayer ascended straight to God in His holy temple. God's holy temple in this case refers to His abode in heaven, of which the earthly temple was but a representation. Solomon himself, who had the earthly temple built in Jerusalem, had said in 1

dwell on the earth? Behold, heaven and the heaven of heavens cannot contain You. How much less this temple which I have built!"

Jonah's thinking has finally been corrected. Earlier, he foolishly tried to run from the presence of the Lord. But now he acknowledges that God is indeed everywhere and is hearing the prayer that is being uttered from the depths of the sea. Many years before Jonah lived, was everywhere present and wrote about it in Psalm 139:7-10. "Where shall I go from Your Spirit? Or where shall I flee from Your presence? If I ascend to heaven, You are there! If I make my bed in Sheol, You are there! If I take the wings of the morning and dwell in the uttermost parts of the sea, even there Your hand shall lead me, and Your right hand shall hold me.'

The prophet continues his prayer in verse 8, and brings out the stark contrast between the

omnipresent, omniscient, omnipotent God and the idols worshiped by so much of mankind: "Those who regard worthless idols forsake their own Mercy." Here Jonah describes all other gods besides the true and living God as "worthless idols." The word translated "worthless" is literally "emptiness." The idols that people worship are nothing; they don't even exist, and yet they seduce people away from the living God. And being deceived by worthless idols, those who worship them cut themselves off from the only true God from whom they could obtain mercy. Jonah is expressing the fact

that all unbelievers are tragically misguided and are missing out on the only Source of help. Believers in Christ, we should be deeply affected by this fact. We sage of eternal hope that every person needs to hear. Let us not be silent about it. May God give us boldness to tell others that all of us are born in a state of enmity against the One who created us (Romans 8:6-8) and are desperately in need of the salvation that He provided through faith alone in Christ's complete and perfect payment for all the sins of all God's people. Oh, may believers everywhere be emboldened to speak this vital truth with love and compassion.







There is a phrase that says: No good deed goes unpunished. What it means that sometimes vou can do something you think is the right thing, but instead you end up making things worse than if you would have let it alone. I am sure we have all been in the position at one time or another, thinking that our idea of what should be done was the best way and now maybe we have lost a friendship or sometimes even the love of a family member.

There is something in the human nature of most of us that when we come on a situation that we think is wrong, we have the innate desire and sometimes need to make it better. It can be a good thing in a lot of cases as there are lots of times that being the person that reaches out to help someone could be not only the right thing to do but may be necessary for life or death. But sometimes our actions have unforseen consequences or at least unlooked for consequences. Just because something looks like it needs to be fixed, does it or maybe we just think it does.
