



Mound Church, Rhame, ND in Need of Repairs

On August 21st, 2022 a public meeting was held to decide the future of Lyle Presbyterian Church (Mound Church), rural Rhame, ND. At the community meeting the decision was unanimous to save the Mound Church, also known as the Lyle Presbyterian Church and fellowship hall which is located about 14 miles north of Rhame, ND. It is a unique little country church sitting on the prairie which took 3 years to build and was finished in 1914. The attached fellowship hall was added on in the early 1920s. Age, wear and tear, and storm damage have made it necessary to bring it back to life. The goal is to re-side, tin the west side of the roof, (there is tin on the east side) and rebuild the eroding foundation on the church. The hopeful plans for the fellowship hall are to replace it and make it a community hall possibly adjacent from the church, and adding an indoor bathroom.

The existing fellowship hall has had rain damage exposing mouse infested insulation, and extensive damage to the roof and ceiling. The foundation is in very poor condition and has become a haven for some of the wild animals in the area adding more destruction to the fellowship hall. The existing outhouses are also in poor condition. Even though they do their part, an indoor bathroom would be so much nicer and more modern.

The Mound Church holds church services every Sunday at 9:00 AM. with a fellowship potluck following the services. Memorial Day Services have also been held there for many many years honoring our veter-

We have had two rough estimates and they both came to \$150,000 dollars as of now. This is an astronomical dollar amount for the church members to come up with, therefore we really need some help. If you are community minded, a believer in the good Lord, believe old is sometimes worth saving, and could help with any monetary donation...it would be greatly appreciated. 

Reflections on the Words of Life

By Pastor Paul Ferrie, Grace Reformed Church of the Lord Jesus, New Leipzig

Before proceeding to the outcome of Daniel's decision to obey God rather than man, let us take one more look at Daniel 6:10-11: "Now when Daniel knew that the writing was signed, he went home. And in his upper room, with his windows open toward Jerusalem. he knelt down on his knees three times that day, and prayed and gave thanks before his God, as was his custom since early days. Then these men assembled and found Daniel praying and making supplication before his God." We have seen that King Darius's wicked advisors, who were jealous of Daniel's prominence in the government, urged the king to pass a law forbidding prayer to anyone

The penalty for disobedience was being thrown into a den of lions. The advisors knew that Daniel was a man of such integrity that the only way to get rid of him was to drum up charges related to his worship of God.

Let us briefly consider why Daniel did not succumb under such enormous pressure. How was he able to stand firm? Well, back in the very first chapter of the book, we learned something about him. Daniel 1:8 tells us, "But Daniel purposed in his heart that he would not defile himself with the portion of the king's delicacies, nor with the wine which he drank: therefore he requested of the chief of the eunuchs that he might not defile himself." As a young man, Daniel requested a diet of vegetables and water for himself and his three friends so that they would not violate the Jewish dietary laws. And in verse 10 above we see that Daniel had cultivated a custom of regular times of prayer since his early days. You see, Daniel had developed a strong resistance to sin because of a life-long habit of seeking grace to obey God. He had learned the truth of James 4:7: "Therefore submit to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you." Each time we are enabled, by God's grace, to say no to sin, we are more strengthened for the next temptation that comes along.

The other thing that sustained Daniel was remembering that he belonged to God. Though this Scripture was not written until much later, Daniel lived out what the apostle Paul expressed in Romans 12:1: "I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service." Because Daniel belonged to God, he knew that God would take care of him and that even if he were torn apart by lions, he would, as David expressed in Psalm 23, "dwell in the house of the Lord forever."

How ironic it is that amidst all that is going on with Darius and his cabinet, Daniel is the one who has true peace. His en-

consciences and Darius with his foolish decision. But Daniel had peace because he was living in communion with the God of peace. So although the wicked men seem to have the upper hand, Daniel is the real conqueror. He is demonstrating the truth that one plus God is a majority.

Gardeners in Autumn

Jesus said in John 16:33, "These things I have spoken to you, that in Me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world." How does one obtain the peace that Jesus promises, that Daniel experienced? It begins by recognizing that we are not at peace with God the way we nat-

urally come into the world. The Bible tells us that we are in fact at enmity with God (Romans 8:7). But Jesus came into this world to accomplish reconciliation between man and God. In order to be at peace with God, we must have our sins forgiven, and that can only happen when we place our trust in what Jesus did on the cross. While He hung there, He bore the sins of His people and took the punishment that we deserved. In order to be restored to a right relationship with God, we must place our trust in what Jesus did-and in nothing else-to reconcile us to God and thereby make peace between us (Romans 5:1). Friends, have you done this?

The Hettinger County Weed Control Board will be dispersing Tordon, Curtail, and Milestone at the STORAGE BUILDING LOCATED NORTH OF THE COURTHOUSE IN MOTT at 336 Pacific Avenue in Mott, from 9 AM to Noon, or until all chemicals on hand is dispersed, on Thursday, September 15, 2022. We will be having a "DRIVE-THROUGH" operation again this year, so you will not have to get out of your vehicle. Bringing your own pens will be helpful.

All landowners / operators must supply a land / FSA map of the area that is to be treated. The Weed Board will need to keep the map.

The cost for chemical will be \$35.00 per gallon of Tordon, \$75.00 per 2 ½ gallon for Curtail, and \$40.00 for a quart of Milestone, with a limit 10 gallons of Curtail, 4 quarts of Milestone, and 5 gallons of Tordon, per producer.

EACH PERSON WILL BE ALLOWED TO PICK UP CHEMICAL AT THE LIMIT ESTAB-LISHED BY THE WEED BOARD. YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO PICK UP CHEMI-CAL FOR ANYONE ELSE, ALTHOUGH A WIFE MAY PICK UP CHEMICAL FOR HER **HUSBAND IF NOT RESTRICTED USE.**

LANDOWNER SIGNATURE IS REQUIRED WITH PAYMENT ALONG WITH THE MAPS AT TIME OF DISTRIBUTION. CONTACT THE COUNTY EXTENSION OFFICE OR COUNTY AUDITOR'S OFFICE TO PICK UP THE FORM PRIOR TO DISTRIBUTION DAY IF NEEDED.

THIS WILL BE A FIRST COME FIRST SERVED DISPERSAL AND WILL BE HELD IN THE ABOVE STATED LOCATION ONLY. IF THE ENTIRE CHEMICAL SUPPLY IS GIVEN OUT THE DISPERSAL WILL BE OVER. SOME ITEMS ARE LIMITED SUPPLY ON HAND.


The Grandsons collected enough candy to keep us all on a sugar high until Halloween. The bounce houses were a big hit with them as
