

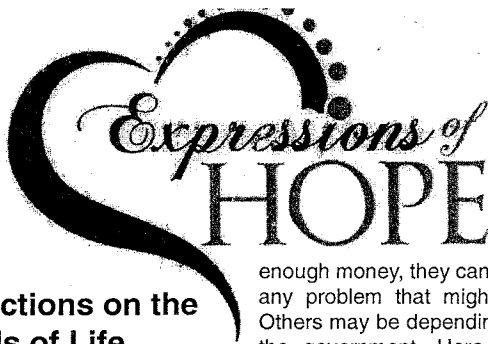

**Reflections on the
Words of Life**

Anyone involved in the construction business can tell you that when building a building, the most important step is the foundation. If the foundation is bad, it doesn't matter how good the rest of the building is—the building simply won't last. When a huge storm or earthquake comes, the building built on a less than adequate foundation will crumble.

What is true of buildings is also true of our lives. Our lives must be built upon something big enough and strong enough to take us through all the storms of life and death. And according to the Bible, there is really only one foundation adequate for the job. It is Jesus Christ. Yes, the only sure foundation to build our lives upon is a Person. The apostle Paul made this clear when he told the Corinthians in 1 Corinthians 3:11, "For no other foundation can anyone lay than that which is laid, which is Jesus Christ."

And yet, when we look around at the things people build their lives upon, we find that they very rarely build upon Jesus Christ. Some may be counting on politicians, hoping that we will have those in power who can guide the country on the right path. Others might be depending on their bank accounts, hoping that if they have

enough money, they can handle any problem that might arise. Others may be depending upon the government. Here in the United States it has become common for governing authorities to step in and bail people out of all kinds of unpleasant or disastrous situations.

But friends, one look at history tells us that all of these things are a poor choice for a foundation for our lives. Politicians can't keep their promises. Governments do not have unlimited resources. And there are many problems which money cannot solve. What happens when health is suddenly lost? What about the death of a loved one? What about war? And what about when we face our own death? What are we going to do when we stand face to face with a holy God?

My friends, we need something far greater than that which any human being or human organization can provide. We need a solid foundation. And again, the only foundation big enough and great enough is Jesus Christ. It all has to do with WHO He is. While being fully man, He is not ONLY man. He is the eternal Son of God. We read in Matthew 1:23, "Behold, the virgin shall be with child, and bear a Son, and they shall call His name Immanuel, which is translated, God with us." Before Jesus Christ took on flesh and became a man, He existed eternally as God. And as God He is almighty, all wise, and holy. The Bible says that Jesus Christ is the Creator. John 1:3 states, "All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made." That is just one demonstration of His omnipotence. And the eternal Son of God became a man so that He could provide a foundation for our lives. For you see, friends, we are in a terrible predicament. Every single human being is born into this world in a state and condition of sin. Every one of us adds to the problem by continually sinning against God. And God, because He is holy, cannot overlook our sin. Because He is holy, He must deal with our sin.

Jesus became a man so that as One who is both God and man, He could offer a sacrifice on the cross precious enough to cancel the debt of our sin. No mere man could offer such a sacrifice. It is only because Jesus is God AND man that the sacrifice He offered is of infinite worth. Now I hope you can see why He alone can be the adequate foundation upon which any of us can build his

A LITTLE BIRDIE TOLD ME

A Little Birdie Told Me: A person can live in a place for their whole life and not know about the hidden treasures just around the corner. One such place in New England is Cannonball Woodworks owned by Twig Zahn.

Twig has been doing woodwork most of his life: building furniture and the like. One day a friend suggested he try wood turning and the result is amazing. After many years at the craft, Twig has become a true artisan, winning many awards. The time and attention to detail are evident

in every piece on display in his workshop.

Twig's specialty is the "Basket Weave Illusion." Pieces of segmented wood are painstakingly glued together to create a vase shape. Once the glue is dried the vase is put on the lathe and turned by his skilled hands. To create the Basket Weave Illusion guitar strings are placed on the lathe to burn the lines. The guitar strings create the horizontal design; vertical lines are done with a wood-burning tool. Patience, a steady hand and good eyesight are a must. Each design is first created on an Excel spreadsheet; the circular designs on plates are done on graph paper as Excel doesn't do circles. Painting the tiny little squares brings the design to life.



The pens are turned from a variety of materials: Plastic bottles are melted down, once hardened are turned on the lathe. The stem of a tumbleweed can be hard-

ened and turned into a pen. Old cedar fence posts are favorite choice of Twig's to turn on the lathe.

Twig is a member of the Dakota Woodturners in Bis-

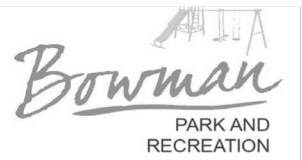





Robert Schnell Rites Held

Robert Schnell was born November 17, 1930 in Dickinson, North Dakota to Ray and



Clara Schnell. There were thirteen siblings in his large family, two of whom died as children. Robert attended St. Patrick's Grade School and graduated from Dickinson High School in 1948. He graduated from North Dakota State University in 1952 with a Bachelor of Science Degree in Animal Science. Robert served as Student Body President there from 1951 to 1952. After graduation, he enlisted in the U.S. Army during the Korean War. His infantry training was at Camp Roberts, California. He eventually joined the Veterinary Corps serving as a meat inspector in Stockton, California. It was there that he met Joan Jackson. Joan was working a summer job between semesters at UCLA as a life-guard at the Stockton public swimming pool and Robert was smitten! He spent many hours there and Robert often joked later about fighting the Korean War at the Stockton Swimming Pool.

Robert was honorably discharged from the army in 1955 and married Joan (Jackson) Schnell that same year in Stockton, California. Robert and Joan settled on the ranch north of Lemmon, South Dakota. Besides raising their four children there (Karen, Leigh Anne, Eric and Carter), they also raised registered and commercial Hereford cattle. In addition, together with several of his brothers and father, Robert

was a partner in the Schnell Livestock Markets in Dickinson, North Dakota, Miles City, Montana and Lemmon, South Dakota. He started his auctioneering career in 1955 at the Dickinson Market and later honed his skills at the Miles City and Lemmon locations. He began his purebred livestock auctioneering business in 1956. That business grew to include cattle sales in 23 states and Canada. Robert also was selected to be the auctioneer at national breed auctions in Denver, Calgary and Regina. The highlight of his auctioneering career was in 1968 when he was named the World Champion Auctioneer.

After Joan and Robert's divorce in 1974, they continued ranch operations together with the help of their son, Carter. Robert added a registered Angus herd in 1979 and registered Salers cattle imported from France and Canada in 1985. After he sold his half ownership of the Lemmon ranch to Carter, he moved to Rapid City and continued raising cattle on leased land near there from 1988 to 2005. He never stopped loving the Lemmon ranch and returned most summers to spray weeds for Joan and Carter. He hated certain weeds with a passion, leafy spurge and Canada thistle to name a few.

Robert was an avid outdoorsman and hiker. During the last fifteen years he spent in the Black Hills, he never missed an opportunity to explore them with his beloved companion, Phyllis Bergeron. Much of his time during his final years in Rapid City was spent reading. He had an extensive collection of books and shopping for a Christmas or birthday gift for him usually included the purchase of a new historical non-fiction book.

Worth noting are some of the offices held by Robert which include his positions as President of the American Salers Association in 1988 and President of the World Salers Federation in 1989. Robert was named to the Marketeers Hall of Fame in 1990. The ranch near Lemmon, which he was so proud of, was honored by being selected to host an American Society for Range Management annual tour. It also was the recipient of the 1969 Adams County Soil Conservation award.

Robert Daniel Schnell died on April 14, 2021 in Rapid City, South Dakota, at the age of 90. He is survived by his children, grandchildren, great grandchildren, two brothers, one sister and a host of nieces and nephews.



Ron attended school in Bowman where he was involved in music, football, basketball, baseball, and track until graduating in 1957. He furthered his education at Jamestown College and graduated in 1961 with a degree in Music Education. Ron went on to teach high school band and chorus in Bowbells and Flaxton, ND before returning to Bowman in 1964. He started an award-winning marching band program, competing in the Cheyenne Frontier Days and the Calgary Stampede. Ron was a very influential teacher and mentor, touching the lives of many students. He continued to teach in Bowman and Rhame until 1970.

While teaching in Bowman, Ron caught the eye of second grade teacher Orpha Mae Mahin and on August 12, 1967, they were married. To this union 3 daughters were born: Kirsten, Renae, and Alison.

Ron went into farming and ranching full time and became owner of the Bowman Charolais Ranch. His love of Charolais turned into 24 years of registered bull sales. He was

a member of the ND Charolais Breeders Assoc. Board of Directors and President and a member of the ND Beef Cattle Improvement Assoc. Ron acquired many awards throughout his ranching/farming career: Outstanding Young Men in America, 1980, NDSU Agriculturist of Bowman County, 1980, Who's Who in ND, 1984, NDCBA Seedstock Producer Award, 1988, American International Charolais Association in Houston, TX, 1989, and Bowman/Slope Achievement winner in 2003.

Music was ingrained in Ron's life from an early age. He could play trombone, cello, pick a guitar and plunk a piano. But most of all, he sang and directed. He was the director of the Bowman Community Chorus from 1972 until semi-retiring in 2019. Ron was a vocal director and male lead in the productions of "Unsinkable Molly Brown," "Showboat," "Annie Get Your Gun," "The King and I," and "South Pacific". Ron was always in charge of directing a choir of cousins during the talent show of the numerous Bowman family reunions.

The Bowman United Methodist Church was also an integral part of Ron's life. As a child, he served as "water boy" and "brick boy" for the construction of the original church in 1949. Ron also directed the church choir for many years and could be found performing solos on holidays such as Christmas and Easter and singing at weddings, funerals, and grandchildren's baptisms. The "Lord's Prayer" and "He's Alive" were just a couple of the song selections he was known for. Ron was also a member of the church Board of Administration and was very instrumental in the addition of the Fellowship Hall.

Ron loved the outdoors and while farming or checking cattle he would also be scouting for deer, antelope, pheasants, and any other animals. Though he enjoyed hunting it was more about being out in nature and spending time with those he hunted with. His daughters and grandchildren were often told they would, "get a nickel for spotting the first deer," but rarely was there a payout.

When Ron and Orpha retired from the cattle business,

they were involved in "Nomads" for nine years and traveled to different churches in Arizona and Texas helping with repairs, painting, and upkeep. They also volunteered with the Theodore Roosevelt Medora Foundation from running mini golf to serving brownies at the fondue. Ron loved the Medora musical and every year it was "the best ever."

Ron was very skilled at leather tooling, making beautiful Bible covers, and many other keepsake pieces. He also loved woodworking, golfing, fishing, driving his father's 1948 Willys Jeep, traveling, photography, and was known to give lengthy slide show presentations. Most of all he loved the farming way of life and spending time with his family.

Ron is survived by his lov-

ing wife of nearly 54 years, Orpha, daughters Kirsten (Nate) Belcher, Renae (Chris) Lunde, Alison (Justin) Reisenauer, grandchildren Grace, Nadya, and Amina Belcher, and Zachary, Grant, and Anna Mae Lunde. Other family include brother-in-laws Sherman Oakland, and Bill (Peggy) Tarnasky. Nephews and nieces, Jeff (Kim) Oakland, Beth Mollman, Paul (Lisa) Tarnasky, and Jill (Dave) Schmid.



RECIPE OF THE DAY

CHICKEN FAJITAS FOIL PACKETS

2 medium bell peppers
2 medium red onions
1 - 15 oz. can black beans
2 tablespoons taco seasoning from a 1 oz. packet, divided
1 teaspoon black pepper, divided
4 - 6 oz. boneless, skinless chicken breasts

Heat an outdoor grill to medium-high, direct heat, prepare 4 (10 inch long) sheets of aluminum foil. Prepare the following, placing them all in the same large bowl: Slice 2 medium bell peppers and 2 medium red onions, and drain and rinse 1 can black beans. Add 2 tablespoons olive oil, 1 tablespoon of the taco seasoning, and 1/2 teaspoon of the black pepper, and toss to combine. Divide the vegetable mixture between the 4 sheets of foil, leaving a 2-inch border on all sides. Season 4 boneless, skinless chicken breasts with the remaining 1 tablespoon taco seasoning and remaining 1/2 teaspoon black pepper, then place a breast on each vegetable pile. Fold the sides of the foil to meet over the center, then crimp the edges together to create completely sealed packets. Place the packets directly onto the grill grates, cover, and grill until the chicken is cooked through and the vegetables are tender, 20 to 25 minutes. Let cool for 10 minutes before opening the packets and serving.

OVEN COOKING: To cook the packets in the oven, place onto a rimmed baking sheet and roast at 425°F for 20 to 25 minutes.
