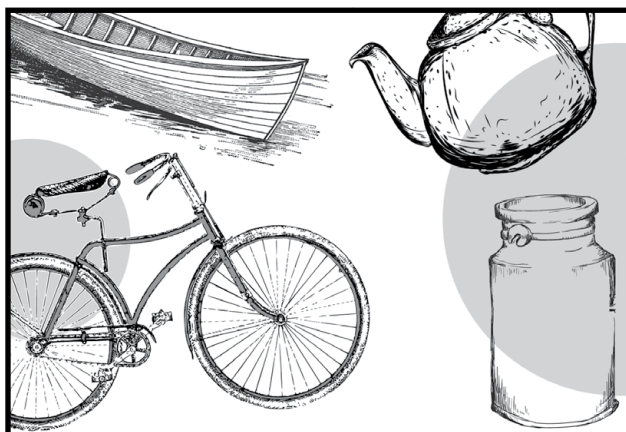

**Dr. Toshi Is In!**

Dear Dr. Toshi,  
 I've had a cough for over three weeks. Could I have pneumonia?  
 Coughing is one of the most common reasons why patients go see their healthcare provider. A cough can be categorized as acute (new) or chronic (going on for a while), and there are many different causes of coughing. So, today, I will discuss some of the most common causes of a cough.  
 An acute cough for adults is defined as a cough that has been going on for less than three weeks. A very common reason for an acute cough is an upper respiratory infection (URI) such as a common cold. (A cough from a viral URI can last up to six weeks!) Other possible causes of acute cough include exacerbation (a worsening condition, or an attack) of a chronic lung disease such as COPD (Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease, such as emphysema), irritation in the throat, blood clots in the lungs, or as in the question today, pneumonia

deep in the lungs.  
 A cough lasting longer than three weeks is called a chronic cough. Common causes of a chronic cough in adults include "upper airway cough syndrome" (the new medical term for "post-nasal drip"), asthma, and GERD (gastroesophageal reflux, also known as "acid reflux"). For children, GERD is not very common, but asthma is. Other causes include foreign objects in the throat and other types of lung diseases such as cancer, but they aren't as common. Stress can even be a cause of a chronic cough!  
 You may have been asked by your doctor or other provider if you have postnasal drip ("upper airway cough syndrome") when you had a cough. Postnasal drip can cause coughing, but interestingly, patients may not notice that they have post nasal drip because it's "silent." Asthma can also cause persistent coughing in adults, and that's actually very common for children. People with asthma can have other symptoms like wheezing and shortness of breath, but there is something called a "cough variant asthma" in which coughing is the only symptom.  
 Gastroesophageal reflux (GERD) is thought to be the second or third most common cause of persistent coughing among adults. Many people who have this also say that they have heartburn or a sour taste in their mouths, but more than 40% of people who have a cough due to GERD don't have those symptoms.

Another common cause of coughing among adults is a type of medication called an ACE inhibitor which is used to lower your blood pressure. One very common ACE inhibitor is lisinopril. For people who get a cough from an ACE inhibitor, the cough usually begins within a week or two of when they start taking it, but it can start up to six months later. It can cause a tickling, scratchy or itchy sensation in the throat, but the cough usually goes away within a few days of when a patient stops taking it, though it can take up to one month for the cough to go away.  
 There are many, many other causes of a chronic cough, and some of them are serious, so if you've had a cough for a while, you shouldn't just ignore it. One interesting cause of a chronic cough, and you may even know someone who has it, is called, "oto-respiratory reflex," also known as an "ear-cough." People who get irritation in their ear canal from a foreign body such as a Q-tip, ear bud, or ear wax can experience a really bad, persistent dry cough. I once had a patient many years ago with this condition who literally couldn't stop coughing and was in tears because of it. We

 Coughing can also cause complications such as fatigue, insomnia, headaches, urinary incontinence, hoarseness, and even broken ribs! Although you may think you know the cause of your cough, if you're concerned or not sure, or if there is a major change in your cough from your regular type of cough, please see your doctor or other medical provider.

## Expressions of HOPE

### Reflections on the Words of Life

by Pastor Paul Ferrie, Grace Reformed Church of the Lord Jesus, New Leipzig

Jesus made many shocking statements. Obviously, He put things the way He did to get people to think carefully about their lives and their relationship to God. One of those striking statements of Jesus is found in the first part of Luke 6:2: "Woe to you when all men speak well of you." Jesus is literally saying that something is wrong if EVERYBODY likes us.

Now, I can just hear someone say, "Well, I've got that covered. I've had arguments with plenty of people, and I'm sure not everyone likes me." Well, that's not what Jesus had in mind. What Jesus is talking about here is the problem of being a "yes man." A yes man is someone who says just the things that people want to hear. The reason why everybody likes yes men is that they never make any waves. They never disagree with anyone, and they never challenge anyone. They go along with the crowd.

Here in America we are increasingly seeing a dominating spirit of toleration. The name of the game today is "go along to get along." Nobody is wrong. All lifestyles are acceptable. There is no such thing as sin. Even more sad is the fact that such attitudes have crept into the churches. It is becoming increasingly rare for preachers to boldly proclaim the word of God. They no longer call sin what the Bible calls sin. I heard one preacher say that he didn't preach about sin any more because people don't like to hear

that. I heard another one say that he no longer talked about sin because "gospel" means "good news," and what we say to people should be good news.

The problem with that kind of thinking is that without understanding how sinful we are, we will never be driven to seek salvation. You see, people need to hear the bad news before they can see how good the good news really is. When Jesus said, "Woe to you when all men speak well of you," He was indicating that there are times when we need to go against the grain. To tolerate sin or to call evil good is repulsive to God. As the prophet Isaiah said, "Woe to those who call evil good, and good evil" (Isaiah 5:20).

Jesus said in John 15:18-19, "If the world hates you, you know that it hated Me before it

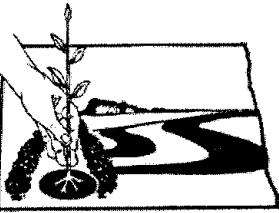

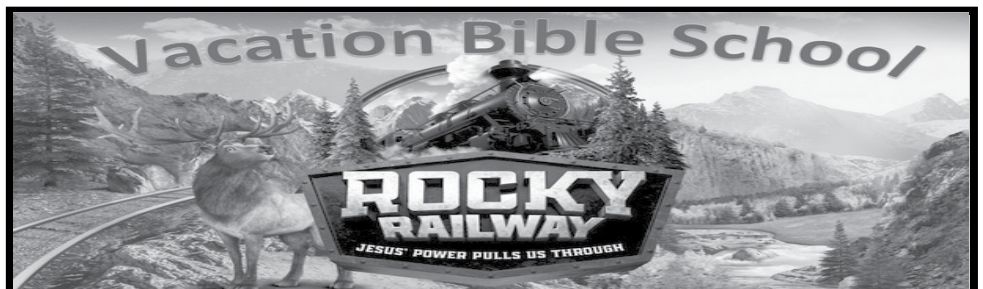

There is always a lot to see as I drive around the countryside. There is the beauty of the scenery as it changes each season of the year. There is the beauty of wheat waving in the wind, the bright yellow sunflowers that grace the fields, the stately stalks of corn as they reach into the sky, cattle and sheep grazing near and far as the eye can see. I believe there is a lot to see when a person just takes the time to truly look.

A second sight I often see and spend more time reflecting upon is when I see an abandoned farm from years gone by. I wonder what the history of the farm is: who the family was who

settled there and began to build a life together. I wonder what it must have been like to start a whole new life full of dreams and expectations. I wonder what it must have been like to have to let go of those dreams and how many years it was before moving became a reality. I look at the buildings as they succumb to the years of wind and rain, sun and snow that has beaten upon them and taken away the luster that once one.

I look at these farmsteads and I wonder. I wonder how God's presence was made known to the family who lived off the land in good times and bad. I wonder how the family knew that God was with them in all that life had to offer. I wonder the same for so many today who work and live off the land that God has created. I wonder how we see the fullness of God's grace and

love in our lives as we live the life that God has given to us.

Let me share this story that came to mind as I thought about the farm buildings I have seen on my travels throughout the countryside. The author is unknown.

**The Weathered Old Barn**

A stranger came by the other day with an offer that set me to thinking. He wanted to buy the old barn that sits out by the highway. I told him right off he was crazy. He was a city type, you could tell by his clothes, his car, his hands, and the way he talked. He said he was driving by and saw that beautiful barn sitting out in the tall grass and wanted to know if it was for sale. I told him he had a funny idea of beauty.

Sure, it was a handsome building in its day. But then there's been a lot of winters pass with their snow and ice and howling wind. The summer sun's beat down on that old barn till all the paint's gone, and the wood has turned silver gray. Now the old building leans a good deal, looking kind of tired. Yet, that fellow called it beautiful.

That set me to thinking. I walked out to the field and just stood there, gazing at that old barn. The stranger said he planned to use the lumber to line the walls of his den in a

new country home he's building down the road. He said you couldn't get paint that beautiful. Only years of standing in the weather, bearing the storms, and scorching sun, only that can produce beautiful barn wood.

It came to me then. We're a lot like that, you and I. Only it's on the inside that the beauty grows with us. 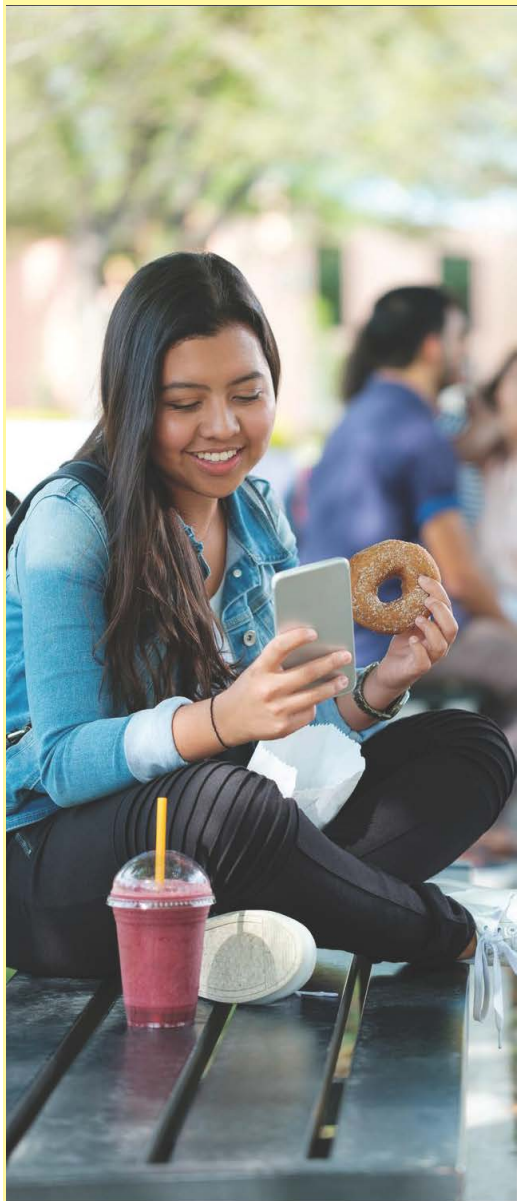

10:30am MT Friday, May 28, 2021 at St. John's Lutheran Church in Carson with Pastor Bethany Haberstroh. Reuben and Lilian's ashes will be interred at 3:00pm CT on May 28, 2021 at the North Dakota Veterans Cemetery south of Mandan, ND with full military honors.

Reuben H. Zeller, 103, Carson, passed away on Wednesday, October 28, 2020 at the Jacobson Memorial Hospital in Elgin.

Reuben H. Zeller was born five miles northeast of Heil, ND on March 19, 1917 to Theodore L. and Christina (Kirschman) Zeller. Reuben attended rural schools until 1925 when the family moved to Carson. He graduated from Carson High School in 1936. After graduation he worked for the WPA and the Grant County Auditor's office before serving in the US Army from 1941 through 1945.

While stationed in London he met Lilian (Margaret) Villars. Reuben and Margaret were married in Flasher on July 30, 1947 and purchased a house in Carson, which they lived in together until Margaret's death in 2009 and where Reuben lived independently until September 2020. Together they had four children.

In 1947, Reuben worked as the village clerk for the Farmers Home Administration and he also farmed with his dad until 1967, at which time he was appointed Postmaster of Carson and served until his retirement in 1977. He was an avid woodworker and many of the business signs he made can be seen throughout the area.

He was a member of the American Legion for 73 years, during which time he served as commander, adjutant, and chaplain. Reuben was appointed chairman of the Grant County Selective Service Board and served for 23 years until it disbanded in the early 70's. He was one of three members of the Village Park Board when it was formed. He was instrumental in forming the Carson Horseshoe Club, which hosted the ND State Horseshoe tournament in 1972. He was inducted into the ND Horseshoe Hall of Fame in 1983 and attended two World Horseshoe tournaments. He was involved in planning the Grant County Veteran's Memorial and seeing it come to fruition.

Reuben loved playing cards. Many games of poker were played in the poker room in the basement of his home, and he never passed up a game of gin

rummy. He and his family had marathon games of Tripoley at every family gathering right up to September 2020.

At the end of September he entered assisted living at Dakota Hill and in October was hospitalized at Jacobson Memorial Hospital in Elgin.

Reuben is survived by his four children: John Zeller of Jamestown, twins Kathleen Ripplinger (Pete) of Billings, MT and Christine Zeller of Flasher, and Julie McCabe (Randy) of Bismarck; six grandchildren: Alanna Zeller (Brady Laub), Melissa Ripplinger, Dawn Ripplinger, Steven Zeller, Jamie McCabe and Jason McCabe; and one great-grandson: Kiernan Ripplinger.

### A Day in the Life of a Nigerian Youth Corper(Peace Corps worker)

*This story was written by a graduate student from the University of Lagos, in Nigeria. Moyinoluwa Zennat Agbaje who is the daughter of Hannah, our guest from Nigeria. We hear news stories, but what is it really like on the other side of the world. Hopefully this story helps us see. The words in parenthesis are used to explain the words she used, some words in her language we don't understand. Read and enjoy.*

I was looking forward to the next stages of my life, one of which was the compulsory one-year service as a Nigerian Youth Corper, after graduating from college in 2019.

I was called up to serve in Sokoto, Nigeria, after waiting a few months. My parents, particularly my mother, did not want me to go because Sokoto is in the far north, and the north is not safe due to constant reports of terrorism, kidnappings, and banditry.

Around 8 p.m., I arrived at Wamakko Camp in Sokoto, checked in, completed and submitted the required paperwork. Because it was after dinner, there was no food. I went to bed early because I was exhausted.

4:00 a.m.: Get up! Get up! Soldiers' voices could be heard waking us up for our daily routine. It was 4 a.m. when I checked my watch. 'Who gets up at 4 a.m.'? 'Is this my life? God!'

After failing to get back to sleep, I crawled out of bed to get bathing water. After queuing (lining up) for about ten minutes, I was able to get a bucket of water, but the bathroom was full and I was running out of time. I was able to take a quick bath despite the cold outside (Is this Canadian weather, I asked myself, I was almost numb due to the cold) and get ready for the day in my all-white outfit (white shorts, white T-shirt, and white

shoes).

5:00 a.m.: The morning devotion has begun. In the last two minutes, I've yawned at least twenty times. Aren't these people shivering? The morning devotion lasted approximately one hour.

6:15 a.m.: The parade preparations have begun. I'm not doing this again. For the past thirty minutes, we've been repeating the same drills. We were singing the NYSC (National Youth Service Corp) anthem when a girl next to me says, "under the sun, or in the rain, with dedication and selflessness..." It must be a mistake, but I stan (respect my colleague opinion) a queen!

8 a.m.: Breakfast is served. I didn't bother collecting the food for that morning because it was just bread and tea that had seen better days. While listening to the room leader go over the rules of the room, I ate my cereal and organized my box and other belongings (Yes, we need a leader in a room of over 20 girls).

10 a.m.: We reconvened for SAED (Skills Acquisition and Empowerment Development) lectures on a topic that wasn't even relevant to me. My skin had taken a beating after two hours in the scorching Sokoto sun.

2 p.m.: There was supposed to be a lunch break, but I had to finish my registration. I'm starving, and the last thing I ate was cornflakes.

4:15 p.m.: "Left, Right! Attention!" The soldiers perform a demonstration march for us. "What is the point of all of this for

the past two hours?" I wonder.

7 p.m.: I'm out of camp and in a local market known as 'Mami market'. I've discovered a new noodle and egg maker (my go-to food any day). I took my takeout order and slurped my noodles while chatting with my new found acquaintances. Finally, there's a chance to unwind.

8:30 p.m.: Soldiers are escorting us out of the hostel and onto the field "What is it?". Isn't this what suffering is all about?" Outside, there's a party going on. Is it compulsory to attend a party (one of the many questions I ask myself)? Yes, it is true. Having fun is a must even if you don't feel like it.

9:30 p.m.: The party was dull because the DJ wasn't playing any interesting music. Then there's the dancing. People come out to represent their different geopolitical zones by dancing. This was my favourite part.

10:30 p.m.: I'm back in my room, attempting to get a cold shower. "Wahala (problem) for those who take a bath every day! Because I know I won't be able to sleep easily due to the noise in my room, I turn to Twitter to read highlights of people throwing bants (trendy words thoughts) and hurling shades at one another. Mental well-being is essential!

Is it possible for me to do this for the next three weeks? How am I going to get out of this? This isn't what I expected when I signed up.

As I drifted off to sleep, those were my thoughts.

### Mott Gallery Opens Summer Season

After a year off due to covid, the Mott Gallery of History & Art is excited to offer artwork and historic displays to the public again. Thanks to the team of Ron and Marge Herner for giving our wooden sign on the front of the gallery a new life.

Season 2021 begins on Memorial Day to coincide with the Legion Auxiliary luncheon. Lunch begins at 11 a.m. so the gallery will open for visitors from 11:30 until 2:00 p.m. Then from June to the end of September folks can tour the museum Sunday afternoons between 1 and 4 p.m. or by appointment to check out new displays which are added regularly.

The gallery features two floors of Mott history, plus an annex full of agricultural and business items. A Janelle Brackel mural spans the complete length of the annex depicting homesteaders and the trek that brought them here to make a better life on the prairies. During the month of June we will display arts and crafts of local school students from grades 1-12. Students desiring to show items may bring one or two samples of their work to the gallery on Memorial Day between 11:30 and 2:00 p.m. or on June 6, from 1-4:00 p.m. We ask students to include their name, grade, and parental permission to show the work.

July will feature the artwork of Lauren Donovan, a former Mott resident and journalist who is well-known across the state. In August Sandy Helland, resident of Mott, will display her oil paintings. ## RECIPE OF THE DAY

### GARLIC ROASTED CHICKEN WITH PARMESAN GRAVY

- 3 boneless chicken breasts
- 2 tbsp. olive oil
- Salt and pepper to taste
- 1 small onion, chopped
- 3 cloves garlic
- 1 tsp. thyme
- 1 cup chicken broth
- 2/3 cup shredded or grated parmesan cheese
- 3 tbsp. heavy whipping cream

Preheat your oven to 400 degrees. Heat up 2 tablespoons of olive oil in a skillet over medium-high heat. Once the skillet is hot, add the chicken, and top with salt and pepper to taste. Sear the chicken for 2-3 minutes on each side until they are browned, and remove them from the skillet. In the same skillet, add the chopped onion and garlic cloves. Saute for 2-3 minutes until the onions have begun to soften and brown. Add 1 teaspoon of thyme, and stir until fragrant. Pour in 1 cup of chicken broth and whisk in 3 tablespoons of heavy whipping-cream. Toss in 2/3 cup parmesan cheese. You can use shredded or grated. If using shredded, add just a little at a time, and whisk it quickly to combine it with the liquid. Using grated parmesan will allow the cheese to mix more easily with the sauce. Add the chicken breasts back to the skillet with the sauce. Place the skillet in the oven, and roast the chicken for 15-20 minutes until they are cooked through. Spoon the sauce over the top of the chicken and serve topped with fresh parmesan or herbs.

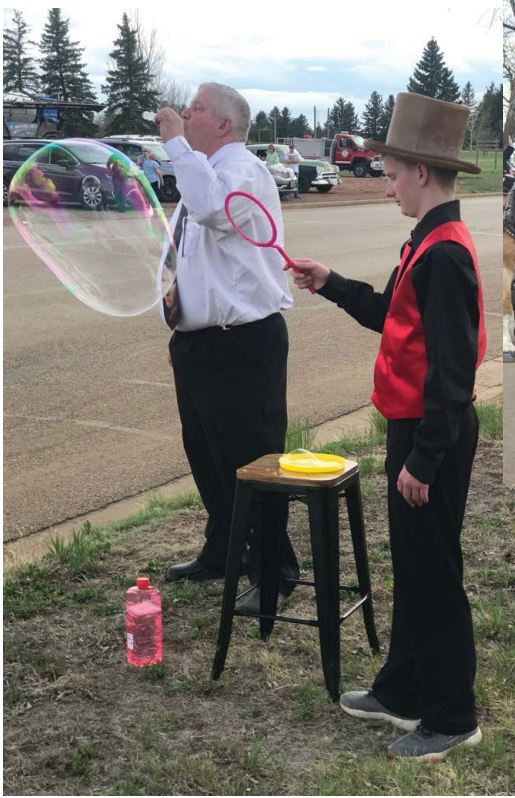
