### Expressions of HOPE

### Reflections on the Words of Life

by Pastor Paul Ferrie, Grace Reformed Church of the Lord Jesus, New Leipzig

We have been looking together at the opening verses of the book of Daniel. We have seen that the Southern Kingdom of Israel, known as Judah, had been besieged by King Nebuchadnezzar of Babylon and that many of its citizens had been captured and carried away as captives. Most of the Jews did not have a God-centered view of what was going on. They were living under the delusion that because the temple of God was in Jerusalem, they could not be ultimately defeated by any foreign power. Instead of listening to the prophets of God who were calling them to repentance, they kept right on in their idolatry, stealing, and lust, while at the same time viewing the temple as a sort of "lucky charm" that would make them indestructible.

The prophet Isaiah had warned them very plainly in Isaiah 39:6-7: "Behold, the days are coming when all that is in your house, and what your fathers have accumulated until this day, shall be carried to Babylon; nothing shall be left," says the LORD. "And they shall take away some of your sons who will descend from you, whom you will beget; and they shall be eunuchs in the palace of the king of Babylon."

You would think that these Jews would know better. The Northern Kingdom of Israel had fallen into pagan hands over a hundred years before. But they were mesmerized by the temple. They thought like this: "We have the temple; we can't be defeated. God could never allow the place of His special presence to be destroyed." And so, when the temple was in fact razed by the Babylonian army, the Jews were utterly devastated and thought that God had forsaken them.

Now if the people of Judah

couldn't understand what was really going on, the people of Babylon most certainly could not. When Nebuchadnezzar took over Jerusalem, he took some of the articles from the temple and brought them back to his own country and put them in the temple of his god. For this reason, Nebuchadnezzar and the people of Babylon assumed that they had demonstrated the superiority of their god over the God of the Jews. "We have won because our god is stronger" was the their thinking. But the book of Daniel shows us that neither the Jews nor the Babylonians were right in their thinking. It was in fact because God had not forsaken His people, but still desired their repentance, that He so severely disciplined them for their sins. By sending the Jews into captivity, God was giving them an opportunity to think about their sins and turn back to Him. And as for the victory of Nebuchadnezzar—the Babylonian army was simply a temporary rod in God's hand for administering that discipline to His people.

An important lesson for us to learn here is that God is always faithful to His own Word! He will do what He has spoken. He is faithful to bless as He promises, and He is no less faithful to chastise and judge.

Friends, what might some in our day be trusting in to make our country secure? Surely we have seen that the government is a false hope for security. Certainly we cannot claim that America is a Christian nation which must be under God's protection. Sadly, our society has turned its back on God and spit in His face for decades now. We have rejected His Word and refused to acknowledge Him even as Creator, teaching our children in school that the universe got here by some "big bang" and that they got here by billions of years of evolution. God has been taken out of the picture. People are being told that they can choose whatever sex they want to be. People are being told that it is fine to murder unborn babies. Can we expect that God will continue to bless this nation? Let us not fall into the same misconceptions as the Jews of the Southern Kingdom did. I do not pretend to know what lies ahead for our country. I do know that God is very patient and merciful, but He is also absolutely holy and cannot allow unrepented sin to endlessly go unpunished.

We read in Romans 1:18, "For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who suppress the truth in unrighteousness." So whatever we might be facing in America, let us be sure that our souls are prepared.

If you have not placed your trust in the Lord Jesus Christ alone for salvation, please make it your top priority to have dealings with God. Tell Him that you realize you have sinned against Him and need His forgiveness. Tell Him that you are relying on Christ's sacrifice on the cross alone to restore you to a right relationship with Him. If you sincerely do that, He will not turn you away. He will make you His own beloved child. He will be your gracious and loving Father who will keep you. If not FROM disaster, He will keep you THROUGH disaster. And no matter what happens, you can look forward to spending all eternity with Him in heaven. No more sorrow, no more tears, no more pain, no more suffering—forever.

# Adams County and West Fargo Receive Community Development Award

WEST FARGO, N.D. – Governor Burgum presented two Community Development Awards Oct. 13 during the Economic Development Association of North Dakota’s (EDND) Fall Conference. ## RECIPE OF THE DAY

### GLUTEN-FREE PUMPKIN OAT PANCAKES

1 cup pumpkin puree  
1/4 cup milk of choice  
2 tablespoons coconut oil (or butter), melted  
1 tablespoon lemon juice (about 1 small lemon, juiced)  
1 teaspoon maple syrup (or honey)  
1 teaspoon vanilla extract  
2 eggs  
1 cup oat flour (see notes for how to make your own oat flour out of old-fashioned oats)  
1/2 teaspoon baking soda  
1/2 teaspoon salt  
1/2 teaspoon ground cinnamon  
1/2 teaspoon ground ginger  
1/4 teaspoon ground nutmeg  
1/4 teaspoon ground cloves or allspice

In a small mixing bowl, stir together the pumpkin puree, milk, coconut oil, lemon juice, maple syrup and vanilla. Beat in the eggs. (If your coconut oil goes back to its solid state like mine did at this point, just warm the mixture for short 20 second bursts in the microwave, stirring between each, until it is melted again.) In a medium bowl, whisk together the oat flour, baking soda, salt and spices. Form a well in the center of the dry ingredients and pour in the wet ingredients. With a big spoon, stir just until the dry ingredients are thoroughly moistened. Do not overmix! Let the batter sit for 10 minutes. Heat a heavy cast iron skillet/ non-stick pan over medium-low heat, or heat an electric griddle to 350 degrees Fahrenheit. Lightly oil the surface of your pan with coconut oil, butter or cooking spray. If you're using a non-stick electric griddle like mine, you might not need any oil at all. Once the surface of the pan is hot enough that a drop of water sizzles on it, pour 1/4 cup of batter onto the pan. Let the pancake cook for about 3 minutes, until bubbles begin to form around the edges of the cake. Once the underside is lightly golden, flip it with a spatula and cook for another 90 seconds or so, until golden brown on both sides. You may need to adjust the heat up or down at this point. Serve the pancakes immediately or keep warm in a 200° F oven.

**TO MAKE OAT FLOUR:** Pour one cup of old-fashioned oats (do not use quick cooking oats!) into a food processor and process until it is ground well. One cup before and after grinding measures just about the same, believe it or not!
