

(Present)

(Past)

They will be at the party tomorrow.

(Future)

2. Have



Expressing possession or experiences

I have a car.

(Possession)

He has had a great time at the concert.

(Experience)

We will have lunch at 2 PM.

(Future arrangement)

3. Do





Actions and emphasis

I do my homework every evening.

(Habitual action)

She did her best to solve the problem.

(Past effort)

Do you like ice cream?

4. Say



Speaking or quoting

She says it`s going to rain tomorrow.

(Present)

He said he would call later.

(Past)

What did they say about the project?

5. Get



Receiving or becoming

I got a gift for my birthday.

(Receiving)

She gets tired after work.

(Becoming)

Will you get the documents ready?

6. Make

Make ...

Creating or causing

I made a cake for the party.


(Creation)

This news makes me happy.

(Causing)

Can you make a decision?

Movement or travel

I go to the gym every morning.

(Habitual)

She went to Italy last summer.

(Past travel)

We are going to the park this afternoon.

(Future arrangement)

8. Take



Action or Accepting Suggestion

Please take this book with you.

(Action)


She took the job offer.

(Accepting)

Will you take a break soon?

(Future suggestion)

9. Know



Awareness or knowledge

I know the answer to this question.

(Present)

He knew her from high school.

(Past)

Do you know where the nearest coffee shop is?

10. Think



Considering or believing

I think it`s a good idea.

(Present)

She thought the movie was amazing.

(Past)

What do you think about the new plan?

11. See



Visual perception or understanding

I see the mountains from my window.

(Present)

He saw a shooting star last night.

(Past)

Can you see what's written on the board?

12. Want



Desires, Wishes or Invitation

I want to learn Spanish.

(Present)

She wanted a new dress for the event.

(Past)

Do you want to join us for dinner?

(Invitation)

13. Give



Offering or providing

I give my time to volunteer work.

(Present)

He gave her a beautiful gift.

(Past)

Can you give me a hand with this?

14. Use



Utilizing something

I use my phone for work.

(Present)

She used her savings to house.

(Past)

Do you use this app often?

15. Find



Discovering or locating

I always find new ways to solve problems.


(Present)

He found his keys under the couch.

(Past)

Where can I find a good restaurant?

Informing or narrating

Please tell me the truth.

(Present)

She told her story to everyone.

(Past)

Can you tell us more about the project?

Occupation or effort

He worked late last night.

(Past)

Do you work on weekends?

Contacting or naming

I will call you later.


(Future)

Emotions or physical sensations

Attempting

(Past)


