Jr. Firefighter Academy Camp FAQs

Frequently Asked Questions:

What do I need to do to register my child for this camp?

- Please thoroughly read this FAQ document and fill out the Registration Form that
 is linked on the camp website page. Send the completed Registration Form to the
 Education and Outreach Coordinator at educator@denverfirefightersmuseum.org
 or drop it off at the museum during our open hours (Tuesdays Saturdays 10 am 4 pm).
- O You will also need to pay the camp fee of \$60.00 per child in order for your registration to be complete. We can take payment via debit or credit card over the phone at (303) 892-1436 or in person at the museum during our open hours.

• Will I receive confirmation of my registration?

 Yes, the Denver Firefighters Museum will send you an email confirming your registration once you have returned the completed Registration Form and paid the camper fee.

What will drop-off and pick-up look like?

- You may either drop off and pick up your camper curbside in front of the Denver Firefighters Museum building or you can park and bring them inside.
- We require that an adult must drop-off and pick-up each camper each day of camp and that they sign that camper in and out of camp.
- As your child's safety is of paramount importance to us, we require that only those adults who have been designated by their parent/guardian to sign out a camper may do so. Campers may not leave until a designated adult signs them out and provides ID that matches their stated name. (You can list designated drop-off/pick-up adults on the Registration Form. You may update the designated adult pick up list with museum staff before or during a camp session.)
- Please plan to drop off your camper no later than 9:00 am for camp so they do not miss out on any camp experiences. You may drop off your camper as early as 8:50 am for camp. You can also stay after camp with your camper to explore the museum together before the museum closes at 4:00 pm.

• What will campers do at the Jr. Firefighters Academy Camp?

o Campers will get to learn about firefighters, fire science, and fire safety and prevention by exploring the museum galleries as well as participating in hands-on activities in a classroom setting. A guest speaker with a trained dalmatian will

- also be a part of the camp week. Camp concludes for the final day at Washington Park in Denver with pick-up and drop-off there. More details will be provided once you have registered.

• Who will be with my child during Jr. Firefighters Academy Camp?

 Campers will be with our Education and Outreach Coordinator, who has previous experience working with children, during the entirety of each camp session.
 Throughout the week, your child may also work with other Denver Firefighters Museum staff, volunteers, guest speakers, and Denver firefighters.

• Should I send my camper with anything?

- Please send your child to camp each day with a water bottle labeled with their first and last name.
- Please leave any and all valuables (ex: electronics, expensive outerwear, money, etc.) at home as the Denver Firefighters Museum is not responsible for lost or missing items.

How should my camper dress for Jr. Firefighters Academy Camp?

- We recommend that your child dress for a fun and active morning.
- o Close-toed shoes recommended. Please no flip flops or sandals.

• Who can attend the Jr. Firefighters Academy Camp?

- This camp is for children in 1st-3rd grades who have already completed kindergarten.
- o Jr. Firefighters Academy Camp is a drop-off program. In order to foster a cohesive experience, this camp is for registered participants only; therefore, adult guardians and non-registered siblings and friends cannot attend.
