Jr. Firefighter Academy Camp FAQs

Frequently Asked Questions:

- How do I register my child for this camp?
 - O Please read this FAQ document and fill out the Registration Form linked on the camp page. Send the completed Registration Form to the Educator at educator@denverfirefightersmuseum.org or drop it off at the museum during our open hours (Tuesdays Saturdays 10 am 4 pm). You will also need to pay the camp fee of \$60.00 per child to complete your registration. We can take payment via debit or credit card over the phone at (303) 892-1436 or in person at the museum during our open hours.
- Will I receive confirmation of my registration?
 - Yes, the Denver Firefighters Museum will send you an email confirming your registration once you have returned the completed Registration Form and paid the \$60 fee.
- Is there a discount for members?
 - o Yes! Our members get a 10% discount on our camp registration fee.
- What will drop-off and pick-up look like?
 - You may either drop off and pick up your camper up curbside in front of the Denver Firefighters Museum building or park and bring them inside.
 - We require that an adult must drop off and pick up each camper each day of camp and that they sign that camper in and out.
 - As your child's safety is of paramount importance to us, we require that only those adults who have been designated to sign out a camper may do so. Campers may not leave until a designated adult signs them out and provides ID that matches their stated name. (You can list designed drop off/pick up adults on the Registration Form)
 - Please plan to drop off your camper no later than 9:00 AM for camp so they do not miss out on any camp experiences. You may drop off your camper as early as 8:45 AM for camp.
- What will campers do at the Jr. Firefighters Academy Camp?
 - Campers will learn about firefighters, fire science, and fire safety and prevention by exploring the museum galleries and participating in hands-on activities in a classroom.
- Who will be with my child during Jr. Firefighters Academy Camp?

- Campers will be with our Educator, who has previous experience working with children, during each camp session. Throughout the week, your child may also work with other Denver Firefighters Museum staff, volunteers, and guest speakers.
- Should I send my camper with anything?
 - Please send your child to camp each day with a water bottle labeled with their first and last name.
 - Please leave all valuables (e.g. electronics, expensive outerwear, money, etc.) at home as the Denver Firefighters Museum is not responsible for lost or missing items.
- How should my camper dress for Jr. Firefighters Academy Camp?
 - We recommend that your child dresses for a fun and active afternoon. Our last camp session will be outdoors, so we recommend clothes that you don't mind your camper getting dirty on that day. Sunscreen might also be a good idea!
- Who can attend the Jr. Firefighters Academy Camp?
 - o This camp is for children in 1st-3rd grades.
 - o Jr. Firefighters Academy Camp is a drop-off program. To foster a cohesive experience, this camp is for registered participants only; therefore, adult guardians and non-registered siblings and friends cannot attend.
- What if I need to contact the Denver Firefighters Museum or my child during a camp session?
 - Please call the Denver Firefighters Museum's main phone line at (303) 892-1436 and the staff member who answers will be able to assist you and/or locate your child.
- Is it okay to stay after camp and explore the museum?
 - Absolutely! We encourage you to walk through the museum with your camper at the end of the session and explore all the great exhibits on both floors.
- Are you able to accommodate my child with medical allergies and/or special needs?
 - Allergies
 - There will be a section of your child's Registration Form where you can include information about any medical allergies they have. The Educator closely monitors all materials used during activities and snack time to ensure every camper's safety.
 - Special needs
 - The Denver Firefighters Museum is committed to full and equal opportunity for children to enjoy the camp experience, and reasonable modifications will be considered. Please contact the Educator at educator@denverfirefightersmuseum.org to discuss your child's individual needs and modification options.
- Can I register for only part of the week, and if so, is there a discount?
 - Weeklong camps have each camp day structured to build on the previous camp day's experiences. Active participation and attendance of each camp day will ensure your child has a full camp experience. Partial registration is not available, and a discount is not offered for children that cannot attend each camp day.
- What if I need to cancel my camp registration?
