Position Summary

Reporting to the Executive Director of Harvest Prison Ministries (HMP), this team member is responsible for executing major goals and objectives for the organization. This position requires all work to be performed with an attitude of service towards Correctional Staff, Inmates, Volunteers and Faith Community Leaders.

The successful candidate requires strong communication skills as well as a passion to see lives transformed. With a high degree of accountability and the ability to work independently, the Regional Coordinator will be involved in community and partner engagement. We are looking for an individual who has great attention to detail and approaches their work with enthusiasm and an attitude of service.

Key Responsibilities-Strategic Values

- Be well versed and be in keeping with HPM's overarching strategic plans and ministry philosophies, implement the established goals and objectives.
- Support and maintain HMP data integrity through establish reporting systems.
- Input and participation in the development, oversight to implementation of HPM's strategic plans.

Operations

- Liaise with Faith Based Community Leaders and their volunteers, with the goal of training and equipping them to walk in relationship with former inmates.
- Conduct intake interviews with incarcerated or recently release individuals willing to be a part of a faith based mentoring community.
- Provide pastoral care to inmates, former inmates, and victims as appropriate.
- Foster or develop relationships with chaplains or staff at key prisons, parole offices, halfway houses, etc. to ensure a positive working relationship between these entities and HMP.
- Other duties as assigned.
