FIFA WORLD CUP Qat\_ar2022

Did you know?

This will be the first World Cup ever to be held in the Arab world, and it will be the second World Cup held entirely in Asia after the 2002 tournament was held in South Korea and Japan.

It is to take place in Qatar and due to their intense summer heat will be held from November 21<sup>st</sup> to December 18, 2022, making it the first tournament not to be held in May, June, or July.

The final is due to be held on 18 December 2022, which is also Qatar National Day. The tournament will be the last to involve 32 teams, with an increase to 48 teams scheduled for the 2026 FIFA World Cup.
