

The Irish pavilion had a wonderful and successful 2022 Heritage weekend on 30 & 31 July and 1 August at Hawrelak Park. Ireland was one of the original attendees at this festival 40 years ago and we were delighted to be there again this year.

It takes a village to run a pavilion for heritage days, from all the volunteers who make the food, pack the trucks with freezers, fridges, stoves, utensils, pots etc. to bring down to the tent, those who put up the stage, put down the flooring in the tent, run the tent during the full 3 days, shuttle drivers who ferry volunteers to and from the Irish Club to the park, to all the fabulous

dancers and teachers who perform 6-8 shows during the days, and those who are present at teardown, packing the truck, and bringing all back to the Irish club and putting away for another year and packing the stage back into the trailer.

We probably had 100-130 volunteers in total, what a great turnout from everyone and we are humbly grateful to each and

every person who helped us this year. None of this event would be possible without you, thank you, thank you, from the bottom of our hearts and if you enjoyed it this year, I hope you come back and help us again next year!
