We are seeking African-American young ladies in grade 10 for the 2018-2019 school year with a minimum cumulative scholastic grade point average of 2.75 and a minimum citizenship grade point average of 3.0 (No "N's" or "U's"), who can benefit from the personal, professional, cultural and social opportunities for future leaders. Eleventh 11th graders may apply and will be evaluated on a case by case basis.

The Leadership Development Intern Program is a three (3) year program. Participation in each subsequent year in this three-year program is contingent on the intern meeting all requirements during each preceding program year. Each program year consists of six (6) months of enrichment activities, workshops and seminars designed to assist African- American young ladies to effectively lead their peers while still in high school and help prepare them for leadership roles in college and throughout their lives.


