The Carolina Ice Zone's Learn To Play Hockey Program will offer a chance for new players to increase their skating and hockey skills in a systematic and progressive manner. The program offers a high level of flexibility in instruction and is adjusted to teach each player based on his or her capabilities and previous experience. After participation, a player may choose to continue with the Learn To Play program to increase their skills or may be ready for the Jr. Pirate Youth Hockey League.

Prerequisite — Participant should have passed Basic 2 in the Learn to Skate Program, OR have mastered forward and backward skating and gliding and be able to stop on their own.

OCTOBER Cost - \$80/4 sessions*, or \$25 per class walk-on (walk-on participants do not earn gear)

*Brand New Players may be eligible to earn one STAR of gear per month. A limited amount of gear will be available first-come, first-served for brand new players and is not guaranteed. Only brand new players to the game who have not received gear from previous CIZ Star programs, First Goal programs, or equivalent programs from other communities are eligible to earn gear. This program is to introduce and encourage players who do not have gear and have never played hockey to the sport and to be properly protected. *1st Star – helmet, jersey, stick 2nd Star – hockey gloves, shin pads 3nd Star – hockey pants, elbow pads 4th Star – shoulder pads
