Find a a area and stay calm and notice what is around you. Look at the trees around you. After viewing all around, pick out your favorite spot with a tree that you like . Write or draw your answers to the questions.

What do you SEE?

What do you SMELL?

What do you FEEL?

Now that you have found your newly adopted tree. Take this page and hold it against the bark of your tree. With the side of your pencil rub the bark to create a **bark rubbing**.

We may not be able to find out your newly adopted trees age, but we can see **YOU** as a tree! A tree shows it's age by adding a inner ring and pushing it bark out to make more room.

Below using circles draw yourself as a tree, draw a ring for every year you have been alive.

Look around your adopted tree for a leaf that has fallen to the ground. Slide the leaf behind this page and then gently rub your pencil over it to create a leaf rubbing.
