### **Recap of 2023 Operation Santa Delivery**

It's hard to believe that it is February 2024 and the 2023 distribution of gifts to children and the elderly happened almost two months ago. Last week, I had a chance to talk to Aaron Allumbaugh, who heads up the Operation Santa project, to find out how 2023 Operation Santa went. Here are some of the highlights.

- 876 individuals in the Franklin County area received help
- 96 individuals were elderly All the items we delivered were used (except 2 tents)
- Elks received \$15,000 in cash donations to help buy items
- Jackets & boots were a popular ask Our 2023 donations had a product value of \$12,711

With a 34% increase in the elderly population in need, and a facility in Jay, Maine closing, our donations help to bring joy to those in need during the holiday. While the percentage of children only increased by about 3%, many of the same children were served in 2023 as in 2022.

I know that the Elks are always happy to see us arrive with our trailer of goodies. And while I still think they are trying to figure out why we go to Maine from TN; I am thrilled that because of many caring and generous individuals, we are continuing to make a difference in a community that needs our generosity and caring. Thank you for making 2023 a huge success and I look forward to seeing what we can do in 2024.

#### **OUR 2024 GOALS**

Those of you who are regular readers know, our first priority is to gather items in three categories: blankets, hat sets and books.

Our 2024 Goal is to reach **300** items in each of these three categories.

Everything we brought to Maine last fall was used! So we will continue to work on the following extras for the children: tents, ear buds, jackets. cosmetic bags and stuffed animals.

New for 2024 will be to gather craft items, coloring books and crayons!

Seniors are another population that is served by the Elks. Last year, we focused on blankets, socks and toiletries. For 2024, our goal is to gather 45 blankets, 40 pairs of socks and 70 toiletiere bags.

#### ADOPTING A FAMILY

In speaking with Aaron, he mentioned that in addition to the regular donations they receive, sometimes an individual or group will adopt a family. What does this mean?

When the application comes in with the children's wishes and needs, the adopting group goes ahead and buys things for those children specifically and allows them to get a little more. When the adopted family comes to pick up their Chtristmas items, they are told that they are receiving more this year because they were "adopted".

So for 2024, we will be adopting a family. This will require some additional shopping in early November so we can get the items requested and send the them up to Maine. When we get more details about the family (late October), we will be glad to share with anyone who is interested in donating or shopping. for a family in need. Please let me know if you would be interested in participating in this special project and I will keep you posted.
