Lifeguards for the summer of 2025

The City of White Lake is accepting applications for Lifeguards for the 2025 summer recreation program. You must be at least 15 years old to take the course. Completion of a 7-1/2-hour online course is required prior to the in-person training. The online course is on the American Red Cross website.

The city will pay your registration fee to become certified. It is paid as $\frac{1}{2}$ of total at the end of season 2025. If you return in 2026, you will receive the remaining $\frac{1}{2}$ at the end of the season.

You will also be paid for training if your application to be hired is approved by the White Lake City Council prior to your training. We also have a uniform allowance for approved lifeguard swimwear.

If you are interested, please contact the City Finance Officer, or stop by the City Hall for an application.
