We are pleased to announce that the front gates are now ready

The system is now fully functional, and the cameras are actively monitoring the front of the community.

When applying your RFID Tag, please clean your passenger side headlight before applying it to that headlight.



Valuable information:

Each RFID Tag (the tag you put on your passenger side headlight) is associated with your home address and vehicle details such as make, model, color and license plate number. If you get a new vehicle or a new license plate you will need to contact the board and give them those details to them. They will also need to get a new RFID tag issued. The current cost is \$25.00 and is subject to change.

Hurricane/High Winds

If we are under severe weather the gates will remain open until it is safe to operate them again.

Emergency Management

All emergency personnel have been given access to the community via a transmitter that they have in their vehicles that allows them to open the gates.

What happens if the internet goes down?

If the internet goes down the camera system will still work to allow homeowners with the RFID tags to enter. If you have created a Passcode before the internet goes down, the system will still work.

If you have a visitor come to the gate and try to call you from the gate to gain access to the community, the call box will NOT work if the internet is down.


Recurring Pass for companies such as Amazon, Fedex and Kroger

**We don't recommend using the Delivery pass option for recurring deliveries because this code only works for a brief time. You can use Delivery pass for things like pizza delivery. Door dash etc. When using the Recurring option, you have the option to allow them to use the code that you generate for up to 1 year.


How to set a Recurring Pass

The homeowner is going to need to go into the MyQ app


Select guest pass in the bottom right-hand corner of the app



Select New




Select Recurring Pass




***Delivery pass is a good option for pizza or quick deliveries that are not recurring because after the pass has been used it will no longer work.

^{***}Temporary Pass is used for visitors etc.


Create a Pass Name (I have named this one Amazon)



This allows you to set the Access Period. You cannot set the access longer than 1 year.




Set it to all day access



Select both Entry and Exit



Make sure that you review the details and then select Create Recurring Pass



This is what the pass looks like from your screen.

You can share this with the delivery company via email or you can just verbally tell them the number.

Several Companies have Delivery instructions – You can add this number to the delivery instructions.

For example, if you go into your Amazon account, Go to Orders, Account, Your Addresses, you will then see a spot next to your address that says Add delivery instructions, enter the delivery pass in the security code box and then save.
