This position is a leadership role, strategically progressing YRA's fundraising and community connections across the GTA.

As the Corporate Engagement Coordinator, you will be an extremely important part of the team, ensuring that we have the necessary supports to run all upcoming programs and events. You will reach out to, connect with, and maintain relationships with corporate, and individual supporters, of YRA, including, but not limited to, ongoing notes of appreciation, updates on programs and organization progress, and continued engagement for future supports.

Responsibilities/Duties

• Leading the planning and implementation of fundraising events and initiatives directed at corporate sponsors and major donors



- Produce an annual fundraising plan that will meet targets as required for both immediate events and long-term sustainability of the organization
- Work in partnership with other team members, including the Development Coordinator, to expand awareness and support for the organization as a whole as well as individual YRA projects and programs
- Maintaining and documenting all corporate relationships in a professional capacity, and retaining these relationships for ongoing support
- Exploring new avenues for endorsements and donations to optimize funding
- Actively inspiring and encouraging other team members to reach out to contacts, community members and other parties for support and awareness
- Assist with funding applications and project proposals in coordination with other team members
- Participate in social media promotions, branding, and public initiative campaigns to increase support for YRA
- Propose new ideas and possibilities for wider community outreach and corporate engagement

Qualifications

- 1-year commitment, and the ability to attend 1- hour monthly conference calls, and a 3-4 hour quarterly in-person meeting
- A strong intrinsic desire to serve at-risk youth through a start-up non-profit organization capacity
- **Preferred** a minimum of two years proven experience working in a corporate engagement or fund development role including being a part of, or having access to, corporate networks and community shareholder groups
- Preferred previous experience in fundraising and corporate communication
- Ability to be a self-starter and leader, work independently as well as engaging relevant supporting team members when needed
- Experience with start-up organizations
- Extensive interest in issues affecting marginalized or homeless youth, or coachable and willing and open to learn
- Excellent organization skills and attention to detail
- Proven ability to manage complex projects
- Excellent abilities in written and visual communication skills
- Excellent strategic and analytical thinking skills
- Proven ability to handle multiple tasks with competing priorities, while working well under pressure to meet deadlines; and,
- A desire to further grow Youth Rising Above to be a program of choice across the country.
