
Stephen's Ramblings Merry Christmas & Happy New Year! It is that time of year again. Member rigs are either parked for the win

It is that time of year again. Member rigs are either parked for the winter, or packed for a run to warmer latitudes (if not already there!). Safe drives to all heading south and on their return north, and for those staying here, may your batteries hold their charge and the mice stay out of your parked unit.

Our winter will be spent at home. We have various minor maintenance plans for the Class A (hopefully the overheat issue is now solved!). For the travel trailer, some suspension upgrades and interior organization fixes to prepare for our return trip to the Yukon and Tuktoyaktuk in August (nice to have a heated indoor workspace for these winter projects!).

We purchased an EcoFlow Pro Lithium Ion battery unit and solar panels that we can move back and forth between the two RVs. It has a 30 amp outlet that you can directly plug the RV into, and a 12 volt outlet that you can alternatively tie in to the rig. Far simpler than trying to retrofit a lithium power bank into our 2001 Class A (so much needed to be upgraded), and it covers both units so is more cost effective. For comparison, it will over triple the dry camping power available for the trailer, and give us 120v power in it if needed (great for making that morning coffee). Will let you all know how it works out!





We will be doing a print run of new member and position badges early in the new year. If you need a fix or an info change on your name badge, let me know asap as we only do these in batches to keep the cost down.


