

RESPECT CODE OF CONDUCT FOR PLAYERS

Respect Code of Conduct for Players

As a player of Worcester Park Football Club I understand that I am a representative of the club and I will uphold the high standards of respect & promote the high standards of behaviour in the game.

When playing football, I will:

-  Always play to the best of my ability
-  Play fairly – I won't cheat, complain or waste time
-  Respect my team-mates, the other team, the referee and my coach/manager
-  Play by the rules, as directed by the referee
-  Shake hands with the other team and referee at the end of the game
-  Listen and respond to what my coach/manager tells me
-  Talk to someone I trust or the club Welfare Officer if I am unhappy about anything at my club
-  Not argue with the referee, coach, and officials, and accept their decisions about football and my behaviour.
-  Never engage in confrontational aggression or violent behaviour

I understand that if I do not follow the Code of Conduct, any of the following actions may be taken by my coach/manager, County FA or The FA.

I may;

-  Be required to apologise to my team-mates, the other team, referee or team manager
-  Receive a formal warning from the coach/manager or the club committee
-  Be dropped or substituted from games
-  Be suspended from training or matches
-  Be required to leave the club
-  Be fined

Club Rules

-  All kit, coats, bags etc remain the property of Worcester Park Football Club and should be surrendered on demand or when leaving the club.
-  All Membership fees must be paid upfront unless agreed with the club committee. Failure to do so will mean your child will be unable to play until they are paid.
-  No annual subscription will qualify as payment for the above items.
-  If any parents should have any complaints or grievances, please see their respective Manager and if this does not resolve the problem, please contact the Chairman.
-  Children are not permitted into the clubhouse with just socks or boots. They must wear trainers or shoes at all times – football boots are not to be worn inside the clubhouse
