Article I Name

The name of this corporation shall be Battlefield Veterans Village Foundation, Inc.

Article II Purpose

This corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, educational and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code. This corporation will be involved in counseling, and to also engage in activities which are necessary, suitable or convenient for the accomplishment of that purpose, or which are incidental thereto or connected therewith which are consistent with Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. This corporation is organized and operated exclusively for not for profit purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3), Internal Revenue Code.

Article III Specific Purpose

This corporation will engage in activities serving United States Veterans facing issues pertaining to, but not limited to, Post Traumatic Stress Disorder, veterans facing homelessness, and substance abuse recovery programs. These activities will seek to raise awareness, offer support and counseling, and assistance for veterans in need. This corporation is organized and operated exclusively for not for profit purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3), Internal Revenue Code.

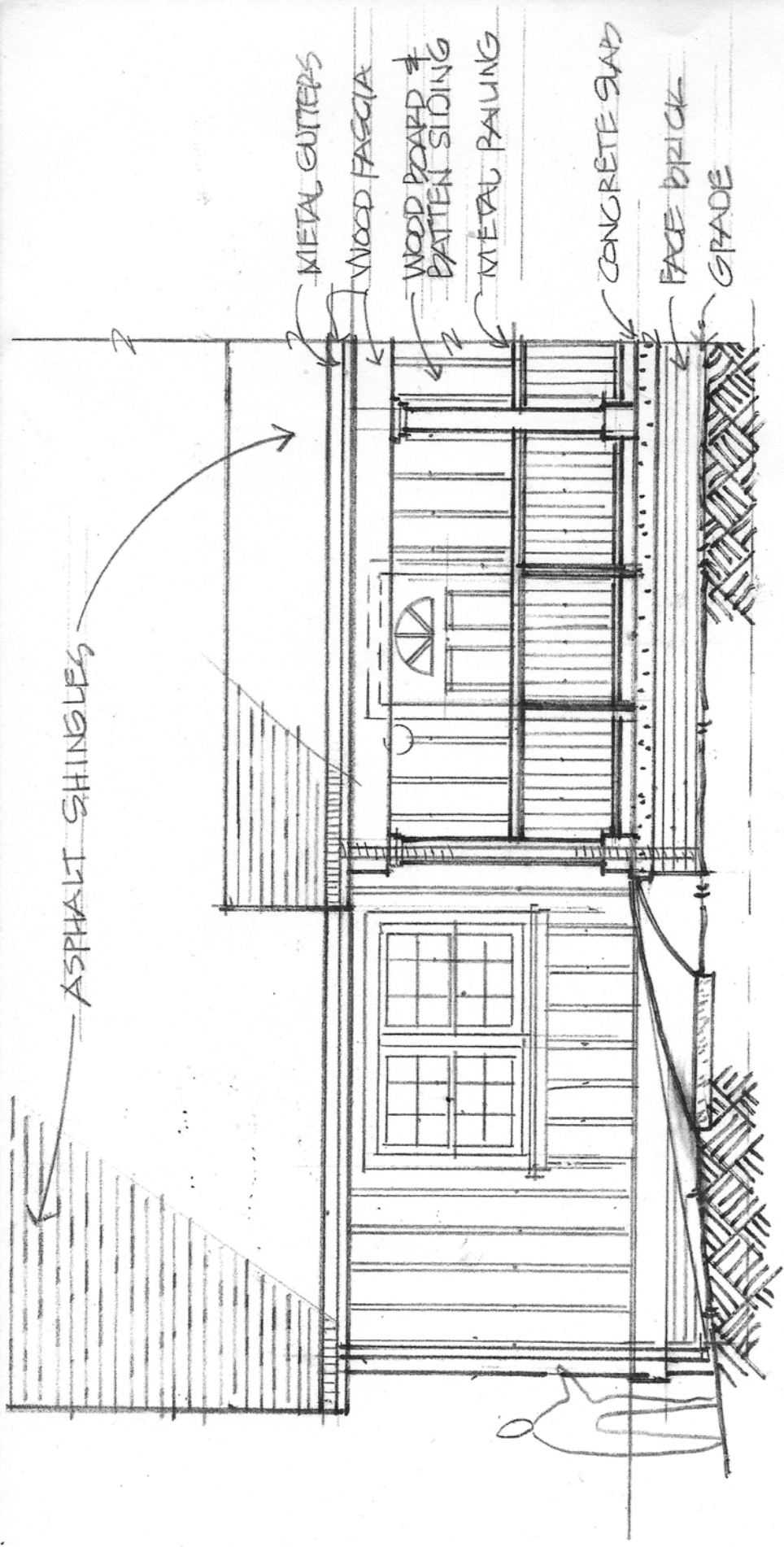
Article IV Membership
