A NOTE FROM PASTOR JOSH

Reading Dr. Kevin Watson's wonderful 4-part series titled "John Wesley's Advice to the People Called Methodists", I am using an excerpt from part IV to highlight an important juncture within our church and denomination. Dr. Watson wrote:

Wesley wrote "Advice to the People Called Methodists" in a context where Methodism was under tremendous pressure. (For more information on the serious internal and external pressures Methodists faced in the first half of the 1740s, I highly recommend Richard P. Heitzenrater's Wesley and the People Called Methodists.) In a time when my own denomination is in a crucible, it is helpful to know what was important to Wesley in the midst of the pressures he was facing.

In controversy, Wesley worked to be as precise as he could be about who a Methodist was. The question of identity was one that Wesley came back to again and again throughout his leadership of this new movement. He was not interested in maintaining something for its own sake. The details of belief and practice were of immediate concern to Wesley.

We, United Methodists, are under a pressure of possible schism from within ourselves. The Special General Conference called for February 2019 will discuss "A Way Forward" for our denomination dealing with the issue of homosexuality within the clerical ranks of the UMC and the language that is currently contained with our Book of Discipline, that; "The United Methodist Church does not condone the practice of homosexuality and considers this practice incompatible with Christian teaching" (BoD 161G).

We need to understand who we are as United Methodists, as a disciple of Jesus, and as a child of God. Our identity has been lost and when we are lost we do not know how to answer the questions of our identity. What makes a United Methodist? What makes a disciple of Jesus? What makes a child of God? What authority does the Holy Word of God have within your life? What power and authority is contained within the indwelling presence of God in your life? Is God in you? Who is God? Who is Jesus? Who is the Holy Spirit?

All these questions rest solely on the question of authority and submission. If we say that there is no absolute authority over our life, then our identity is shattered, and we will believe anything that sounds good to our ears and justifies our fleshly passions. If we say there is an authority over our life, then we can have an identity and a way forward in our walk with God.

We fight because we lost our identity. If we can find our identity once again, then we can confidently walk in love with a strong foundation that is unmovable by chaff blowing in the wind. There will not be a fight for we will know our identity and will not be confused and consumed by idle talk.

It is my understanding that we need to find out who we are, so I am going into my prayer closet and seeking the presence of God to develop a series of sermons to help us recall our identity. I ask that you pray with me, seek the face of God with me, and open your heart to the Words of Holy Scripture as God speaks to us. May God bless those who seek him with their whole heart, Psalms 119:1-3.
