Hello Everyone,

The new year has already begun with things continuing to move along here at Westside. Today I want to talk to you about finances. I know it is not the most exciting topic but I wanted you to know where we are financially.

After our stewardship campaign in the fall, we began seeing an increase in giving and I want to encourage you to continue with what you have been doing. But over the past few years we have lived in a negative cash flow and the Leadership Team and I have decided to change how we are paying back the mortgage.

The past few years we have added over \$1000 dollars per month to our mortgage payment trying to eliminate our debt more quickly. However, looking at the budget and spending; we have come to the conclusion we are unable to sustain that payment structure. Therefore, it was decided to only pay our required mortgage amount in an attempt to not run our finances in the negative.

Please continue to give at your current level so we can maintain our current checking and saving balances and to get us back to ending our debt sooner. The best response to our financial problems is growth, both in giving and especially membership. So, invite a friend to church and help us be the church God has called us to be.
