### A NOTE FROM PASTOR JOSH

Blessings to you all in the name of our Risen Savior!

Are you ready? In these seven Sundays of Easter, we reflect on the victory God gave us through his one and only Son, Jesus the Christ. We recall that life came from death and resurrection came from burial. The two concepts of life and death seem so opposite of each other, yet we know without one we won't get the other. "If death got the upper hand through one man's wrongdoing, can you imagine the breathtaking recovery life makes, sovereign life, in those who grasp with both hands this wildly extravagant life-gift, this grand setting-everything-right, that the one man Jesus Christ provides?" (Romans 5:17, The Message)

We trust in God for our life. Even when there are moments of sorrow and it looks like we are utterly defeated

and lost, God provides us comfort through those who received comfort from God.

All praise to the God and Father of our Master, Jesus the Messiah! Father of all mercy! God of all healing counsel! He comes alongside us when we go through hard times, and before you know it, he brings us alongside someone else who is going through hard times so that we can be there for that person just as God was there for us.
