# **Youth Updates**

The youth have been working through the Wonder Women of the Bible series! We have learned about several women from the Bible and learned some "super hero qualities" that these women possessed. We learned how these ideas relate to our lives and how we can put those great qualities into practice in our own lives.

We learned about Esther and how she had to make a choice to go to the King to save her people. We talked about how, like Esther, sometimes we have to make scary or intimidating choices and trust that God is going to be beside us along the way. Then, we learned about faithfulness from Ruth. Like Ruth was faithful to her mother-inlaw, Naomi, God is faithful to us. Throughout Ruth's highs and lows, God was there. We learned that sometimes we feel like things aren't going well because our plan didn't go the way we expected it to. Ruth's story shows us that God has bigger and better plans for our lives that we could even imagine. Next, we talked about Hannah. Hannah taught us to seek God through painful or difficult times, and to always trust that God hears our prayers. With this lesson, we took time to write a prayer journal to God. After Hannah, we talked about Mary. We learned that Mary was brave and courageous young woman who God had big plans for. We focused on the fact that sometimes, like Mary, God calls "unlikely" people to do big things, we just have to accept that calling He has for us. We are excited to continue in this series and learn how God can work in our lives, like He worked through many women throughout the Bible!

During Lent, the youth are participating in the Westside Discipleship Team activities, including donating 40 Things for 40 Days and writing cards to "adopted" preschoolers. We are also taking on our own challenge of writing scripture verses each day and meditating on those verses as a way to prepare for Easter. We would love for you to join us in the Discipleship Team opportunities!

Coming up at the beginning of April is Converge! Converge is a two day conference held at the Elida Field House that brings together churches from all over Ohio and even other states. This youth event is filled with incredible speakers, small group workshops teaching on specific topics, huge worship sessions, and Operation Love Lima food distribution. Not only do our youth get to learn about God, but they get to worship together, meet new people, and serve the Lima community. This is an incredible opportunity for our youth to be the hands and feet of Jesus in our area.
