Greetings from Pastor Paul Scannell

Hello Westside,

Are you excited? Are you a bit apprehensive? Are you both at the same time?

I know without a doubt I am both at the same time. I will begin with you in ministry on the 1st of July, my first day in the office. My first Sunday will be July 6th and I want to take that time to introduce myself to you. Who I am, where I come from, who my family is, what I enjoy, what I dislike, who I cheer for, but especially how God has gotten me to this point in my ministry with you and where it is we will be going. If you are looking for those type of details here well sorry to disappoint you but you will have to show up to church at 9am on the 6th. Can't make it on the 6th? You can always watch on Facebook live to see what's happening at Westside and hear my story.

Speaking of the 6th I want you to know some of the logistics about how church on Sunday is going to happen. You have graciously changed the time of your service to 9am and I will be doing a service at Elida St. Paul's at 10am every Sunday. Which means I am not going to have much time at the end of service to greet and meet all of you. My goal is to be walking out your door at about the same time as St. Paul's is beginning their service which means if I talk a lot there may be no greeting you after church. But I will be available before church begins every Sunday and on that first Sunday, I will park myself at the back of the church to meet you all before the service begins. I will also be in the office most Tuesdays between 10-4 and I am at St. Paul's in the office on Monday, Wednesday and Thursday 10-2 and Sunday 1-5 (by appointment). You can always call or text me on my cell at 734-660-1984 and I will get back to you as soon as possible. I am usually off on Fridays and Saturdays but there are always exceptions to that rule like on the 12th of July we (yes, you and I) will be Weeding Westside from 8:30am to 10:30am working on beautifying the outside of the church. So, bring a pair of gloves and your gardening tools and meet the new pastor.

Finally, I want to say to you there will be some minor things that change as we move forward in this new relationship but there will be a lot of things that remain the same. I am going to ask you to tell me your story and how it is that you ended up at Westside. I really want to hear your story and how God has gotten us to this moment in time together in this place. I know God will use all of us together to begin to grow the kingdom of God here in Lima, we just have to be brave enough to step out in faith together to do God's work. I see it already happening in the stories I have heard and I am confident that you will be a part of what happens here at Westside. I hope to be filling this section of the newsletter every time it comes out, sometimes I will be repeating myself, other times it will be all new but I believe communication is one of the most important things we can do to maintain a good relationship.
