Steven J. Lehotay is a Lead Scientist with the USDA Agricultural Research Service at the Eastern Regional Research Center in Wyndmoor, Pennsylvania (near Philadelphia). Since 1992, he has conducted scientific investigations and method development research involving improvement in the analysis of pesticides, veterinary drugs, and other contaminants in food and environmental samples. His research has addressed all aspects of the analytical process, including sample preparation, cleanup, separations, detection, screening, quantification, identification, and data processing using many types of analytical techniques applied in novel and useful ways. He has been awarded with numerous honors, including the AOAC International Harvey W. Wiley Award and NACRW George and Wilma Fong Founders Award. He has given >150 invited talks on 6 continents and (co-)authored >150 peer-reviewed scientific publications. According to the Stanford c-score metric, he resides among the top 0.125% of published analytical chemists.
