- We held an **Ash Wednesday** service of worship.
- Two of our sojourners are being mentored in being Christian men. March.
- A "Journey with Jesus" discussion group has been meeting weekly before Dinner Church through March.
- We now have four residents at House of Hope, each working on a variety of important skills to prepare her to become independent and selfsustaining by the time she's ready to graduate from the program.
- Weekly presenters for our lunches include N.A.M.I.(mental health), NCPA Food Bank on healthier choices, Amerihealth Caritas, smoking cessation

- The Mennonite Youth Choir brought musicians for a Saturday Dinner Church.
- A Kiwanis grant purchased materials for the ASK (After School Kids) program.

- Lowes completed the work on 663 Center Street, which will provide transitional housing for our House of Hope graduates.
- Thanks to 2 state grants we are in process of revitalizing our old kitchen cupboards, counters, stove and other equipment!

 We just acquired a Chair Volleyball set to give sojourners opportunities for cardio and upper body exercise, with loads of laughter in playing this non-

competitive game.

The sanctuary/community room renovation is complete, including new windows, lighting, and a sound system. Many thanks to the Harry Plankenhorn Foundation!

 Lycoming County United Way played a big role in our ability to provide almost 29,000 meals in 2023. Without them and our ability to purchase food through the North Central PA Food Bank (with your generous donations), it would be impossible to meet those needs

You get the picture. Sojourner Truth Ministries is multifaceted and meets a myriad of needs in our community, many to provide services and everyday happenings most of us don't have to think twice about. Perhaps it's knowing which social service can help, or how to contact them; a hospital visit from the Pastor; a Bible study or life skills class;



feeling like part of a caring family at STM; a hot meal and/or a few groceries (thanks to Weis and Wegmans); someone to listen to and pray with a hurting soul. On and on it goes. We are both privileged and blessed to meet so many needs.

DID YOU KNOW that we recycle food? We get produce with limited shelf life from local grocers, use what we are able for fresh salads and fruit for our meals, and offer the remainder to our patrons. Whatever is not chosen is then offered to a local farmer. Hopefully there's nothing left, because then we have to pay to dispose of. Are you, or do you know a farmer who could use some leftovers?
