We began as a soup kitchen. In 2024, we served 36,400 meals which was <u>an increase of over 6,000 meals served in 2023</u>. Hot lunches are served Monday through Saturday, plus a sandwich bag is available. For some, the food we provide is all they have. As you can imagine, we need many donors to accomplish feeding bodies and souls. We are so thankful for your time and treasure!

We also make connections to social service programs, our ASK (After School Kids) program, Dinner Table Church Worship, Bible Studies, individual and collective prayer and recognizing each one as a person of value, This makes us so much more than a soup kitchen.
