### Directions

In this project, you will work in Pixlr to create an edited Portrait, from one of the three options. This project will help you understand what a layer is, and how to photographs. You will need to choose one of the three videos Typography, Neon, or Risograph and follow the instructions in the videos.

Create a Portrait that uses a variety of tools in Pixlr. You can add filters, lighting, text, temperature, blur, objects, shapes, etc. Be creative with this project, try something different!

- Answers to the questions

3. Do you think this project was easier or harder then the first editing project? Explain.
