You will choose one career from the list presented in class. The questions below are to guide you on your search for information for the career you have chosen to research. The answers to these questions along with finding photos related to the field are to be used in the creation of a **Power Point Presentation** that covers all the questions including several slides of example photographs (5 points extra if you take your own photos as examples).

Photography Careers Questions (one slide for each question)

- 1. What career in photography have you chosen?
- 2. When was this type of photography first introduced? (An approximate date is ok)
- 3. How many years do you have to go to school for this career?
- 4. List some colleges that offer a degree related to this photography career? Also include how much it costs to go to each school.

(Minimum of 2 schools that offer a related program, then average the cost of the 2 schools).

- 5. How much are you expected to make as a ______ photographer per year?
- 6. Using the information from question 3 and 4, approximately how long will it take to pay off your student loans (assume 2.5% of your salary from question #4 to pay off your student loan debt each year from question #3) round to closest number of years.

Formula: (Total Debt) / (2.5% of Yearly Salary) = Number of Years to Pay Off Loans

7. What is the job outlook for your chosen photography career?

(How many jobs are going to be added over the next 10 years to this career)

8. What type of equipment do photographers in your chosen field use?

(Listing of equipment is acceptable for this slide)

9. What specifically does your chosen photographer do for work? Explain.

(Example: A Marine Photographer works with Marine Biologists to capture images of underwater life and helps document the underwater ecosystems around the world).
