## THE BACKSTORY

- The Cathedral of All Saints dedicated in 1888 was designed by 29-year-old architect Robert W. Gibson. It was his first major work.
- A church campus including a hospital, school, and a convent were added. All are lost.
- Guild House was built in 1902 as a memorial gift to the Cathedral. It served variously as an immigrant settlement house and a school until the 1970's, when it was abandoned.





- The Guild House Restoration will be a multiphased project
- <9000 square ft. Building abandoned since 1970's
- Application to NYS Historic Preservation Office (SHPO) Spring of 2024 for First Phase "emergency stabilization" maximum grant of \$750,000
- Two additional succeeding year grants of \$750,000 each
- \$2.25 million total SHPO investment
- Additional \$2.25 million from other sources
- \$4.5 million total budget (\$500 per sq. ft.)



- Restoring the Guild House cost-effectively is a must as the budget is limited
- Two Paths: Gut & Rebuild or Salvage & Restore
- Can some components, such as floor joists, be reused?
- Can the open roof truss system be exposed?
- Are there creative ways to build out the two floors that must be replaced?
- Are less costly, more sustainable materials available to use?
- Can Artificial Intelligence be used in this project?
- What are the ADA requirements and Building Code requirements for the building? Will an elevator or sprinklers be needed?



- Designing a Geothermal HVAC System qualified for NYSERDA funding
- Integrating the outdoor space into the design



- THE GOAL: Get Guild House "Development Ready" for potential uses
- Possible mixed-use as a learning center devoted to immigrant and marginalized community needs
- Potential as a "public charter school"
