

1 Tim. 2:1-6

First of all, then, I urge that petitions, prayers, intercessions, and thanksgivings be made for everyone, ² for kings and all those who are in authority, so that we may lead a tranquil and quiet life in all godliness and dignity. ³ This is good, and it pleases God our Savior, ⁴ who wants everyone to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth. 5 For there is one God and one mediator between God and mankind, the man Christ Jesus, ⁶ who gave himself as a ransom for all, a testimony at the proper time.

Kinds of Prayer?

Paul mentions four areas of prayer:

- Petitions Special request that you have, a friend has; the situation in Kerr County & the Hill Country
- Prayers a general that speaks for regular prayers that are part of daily worship & devotion (Ps. 119:18)
- Intercessions specific prayers on behalf of others
- Thanksgiving Prayers of gratitude expressed to God for His work in our world...

Who do we Pray for?

- "...I urge that prayers...be made for EVERYONE, 2) for Kings and all whose who are in authority..." 1 Tim. 2:1.2
- Everyone needs prayer... (Eph. 6:18 the Holy Spirit will show you who; Rom. 8:26; Matt. 5:43-44;)
- Kings & those in <u>authority</u> Politics, govt, police, Education; Courts; Church; Family

Remember Paul said: PRAY FIRST

Why do we Pray?

- "...so that we may lead a tranquil and quiet life in all godliness and dignity. 3) This is good, and it pleases God our Savior, 4) who wants everyone to be saved..."

 1 Tim. 2:2,3,4
- It will <u>calm</u> you! Bring <u>Peace</u> & <u>Quiet</u> to us, Luke 18:1
- It <u>Pleases</u> God, v. 3
- For people to be <u>Saved</u> v. 4

Pray for What?

- "...4) who wants everyone to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the Truth." 1 Tim. 2:4
- For people to be <u>Saved</u> v. 4
- "The Lord does not delay His promise, as some understand delay, but is patient with you, not wanting any to perish but all to come to repentance." 2 Pet. 3:9
- For them to Grow in their faith v. 4
- "But grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord & Savior Jesus Christ..." 2 Tim. 3:18

Who will you Pray for?

- By Name Family? Co-workers? Friends?
- By Need Salvation? Spiritual growth? Marriage?
 Finances? Health? Family?

Ask the Holy Spirit to make you sensitive to the spiritual needs of those around you...
