Teach and encourage these things. ³ If anyone teaches false doctrine and does not agree with the sound teaching of our Lord Jesus Christ and with the teaching that promotes godliness, ⁴ he is conceited and understands nothing, but has an unhealthy interest in disputes and arguments over words. From these come envy, quarreling, slander, evil suspicions, ⁵ and constant disagreement among people whose minds are depraved and deprived of the truth, who imagine that godliness is a way to material gain. ⁶ But godliness with contentment is great gain

1. How Do we recognize False Teachers?

- Content of their Teaching, v. 3 "false doctrine...does not agree with the sound teaching..."
 - See: Gal. 1:6-9; 1 Tim.4:1-3; 2 Cor. 11:4
- Character of the Teacher, v. 4 "conceited and understands nothing...unhealthy interest..."

 Matt. 7:15 "...inwardly they are wolves..."
- Fruit of their Lives & Teaching, v. 4-5 "from these come envy, quarreling, slander..." See: 2 Peter 2:1-3

2. How do we Overcome False Teaching?

- Sound Teaching, (<u>TRUTH</u>) v. 3, 5, Rom. 1:18-19;
 2 Thes. 2:10-12; John 14:6; 1 John 4:1-3
- Godliness, v. 3,6,11, 1 Tim. 2:2; 3:16; 4:7, 8
- Contentment, v. 6, 8; Phil. 4:11-13; Heb.13:5
