Titus 2:11-15

¹¹ For the grace of God has appeared, bringing salvation for all people, ¹² instructing us to deny godlessness and worldly lusts and to live in a sensible, righteous, and godly way in the present age, ¹³ while we wait for the blessed hope, the appearing of the glory of our great God and Savior, Jesus Christ. ¹⁴ He gave himself for us to redeem us from all lawlessness and to cleanse for himself a people for his own possession, eager to do good works. ¹⁵ Proclaim these things; encourage and rebuke with all authority. Let no one disregard you.

1. God's Grace Saves, v. 11

¹¹ For the grace of God has appeared, bringing salvation for all people.. Titus 2:11

- His grace “appeared” - Luke 1:79; Titus 3:4
- His grace brings Salvation for All – Free/slave, young/old; male/female; Jew/Gentile... v. 11.
- 1 John 2:1-2; 5:10-13; John 3:16-18

2. God's Grace Sanctifies, v. 12, 14

¹² instructing us to deny godlessness & worldly lusts & to live in a sensible, righteous, & godly way in the present age... He gave Himself for us to redeem us from all lawlessness & to cleanse for Himself..."

- His grace Instructs us to:
Deny Godlessness; Live godly.
- He redeems (ransoms) us & cleanses us, v. 14
- Eager to do good works, v. 14; Eph. 2:8-10

3. God's Grace Sustains, v. 13

¹³ while we wait for the blessed hope, the appearing of the glory of our great God and Savior, Jesus Christ.

- Grace to “wait” – to look for with confident expectation!
- Confident hope – in Jesus!
- Looking; Longing & Loving His appearing. (Jesus' return is our Blessed Hope!)

4. God's Grace to be Spoken, v. 15

“Proclaim these things, encourage and rebuke with all authority. Let no one disregard you.” Titus 2:15

- Proclaim is to talk about, preach, to speak **LONG** and **LOUD** about...
the Grace of God that **SAVES; SANCTIFIES & SUSTAINS** us **UNTIL** Jesus Comes!
