

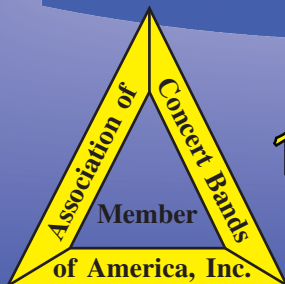
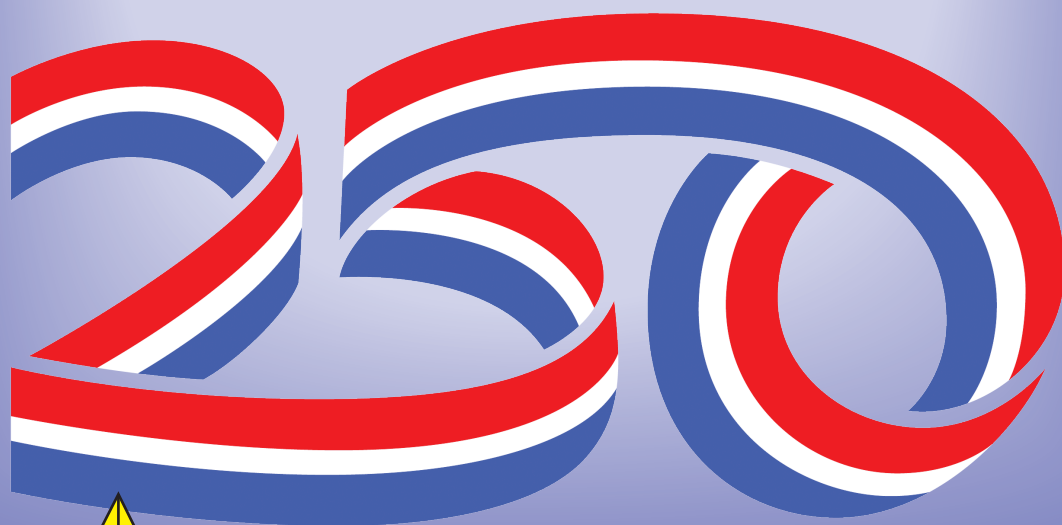

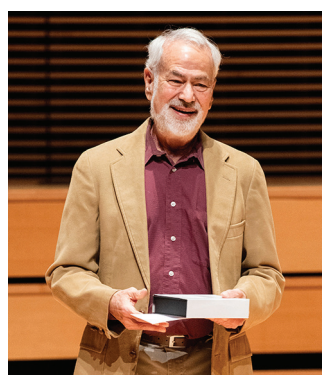

Mark Eichner was awarded the Racine Arts Council 2026 Heart of the Arts prize for longstanding artistic commitment, positive impact on the thriving Racine Arts scene, dedication and leadership of the Racine Concert Band since 2002, and education outreach activities in RUSD high schools.

A music educator for 41 years, he was the Wind Ensemble and

Community Band Conductor, trumpet instructor, and a teacher of coursework in Music Education at UW-Parkside from 1982-2014. He served as Department Chair from 1998-2007.

As a trumpeter, he performed in the Milwaukee Symphony Orchestra, the Wisconsin Philharmonic, the Chicagoland Pops Orchestra, the Brass Band of Battle Creek, the Florentine Opera, the Woodstock Mozart Festival.

As the founder of BrassWorks, he led brass quintet performances including a nationally broadcast concert at the Chicago Cultural Center, civic festivals, university recitals and assisted the Canadian Brass in their Wisconsin tour performances.

Don Rosen is a broadcast veteran of over 50 years. Currently, he is heard mornings 6-9am on WRJN: 1400 AM, 99.9 FM and 98.1 FM. Don and his wife Terry have always been fans of the Racine Concert Band Sunday night concerts at the zoo.
