



Cusco / Machu Picchu Peru 2025

August 30 Saturday) - September 5 (Friday)

This mission is designed to bring Medical/Dental care to the remote communities of Cusco, Peru. We will be focusing on communities that are off the tourist trails. This is going to be a unique and rewarding mission. We will work in 3 different remote communities, each in desperate need of Medical and Dental care.

We have set up the mission so that you should arrive Saturday early in the morning (no later than 10 am) in Cusco, and you will have a chance to see a bit of the world-renowned Plaza de Armas. Your flights home can be scheduled Friday morning

We will stay Saturday in Cusco, Sunday in Pisac, Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday in Ollantaytambo, and Thursday back in Cusco. We will be working in clinics Sunday, Monday and Tuesday.

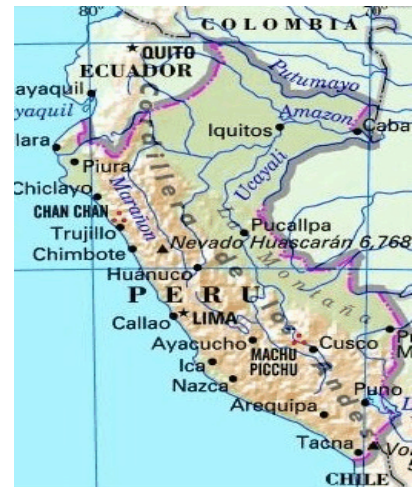
Wednesday morning we will have the privilege of visiting the famed Wonder of the World, Machu Picchu, and Thursday we will go on an adventure exploring the incredible beauty and culture of the Andes Mountains.

August 29th Friday -Depart the USA

Flights from the USA usually arrive late at night. Depending on your arrival time, you may have time to stay in a hotel overnight (not provided). It may be best, if your flight arrives around 4am Saturday morning (as some do), to consider staying in the Lima airport, which is clean and safe, until your connecting flight to Cusco.

August 30th-Arrive in Cusco 11,152 ft

In Cusco you will be met by your Team Leader. You will get a quick briefing and then you are off to see the famed Plaza de Armas! Here you will get a cup of coffee or mate de coca (best for altitude) with lunch, where we will meet our team of local interpreters, and settle in at a comfortable hotel in Cusco. You will have a chance to relax and explore the colonial city, followed by our traditional "meds" party where we unpack and organize our medications and supplies for the work days ahead.



August 31st Sunday -Medical/Dental Clinic at Quello Quello.
We will leave Cusco early on the morning and travel on a breathtaking journey into the Andes to this beautiful and remote community in the Sacred Valley.

September 1st Monday- Medical/Dental Clinic at Amaru Community

September 2nd Tuesday- Medical/ Dental Clinic at Socma community

September 3rd- Wednesday - Machu Picchu. We will board the famed Inca Rail Train as we embark on our full day journey to this eternal testament to the grandeur of the Inca Empire. This ancient citadel, shrouded in mist and mystery, beckons intrepid adventurers and history enthusiasts alike. As you explore its awe-inspiring terraces, intricate stone constructions, and panoramic vistas, you'll be transported back in time to a world of unparalleled wonder and discovery. Machu Picchu isn't merely a destination; it's a pilgrimage to the heart of ancient civilization, where every stone tells a story, and every corner reveals a hidden treasure.



September 4th Thursday -Destination TBT. Full day tour/hike exploring the spectacular sites and culture of Peru. Afterwards we return to Cusco to spend our final night, which includes our “Adios Amigos” dinner, where you can say goodbye to your new friends and Peruvian coworkers.

September 5th Friday: return to USA. Your mission concludes after breakfast
