We will spend the first day in the modern capital of Addis Ababa before we head out to Lalibela, home of the ancient rock churches. We will be working with the medical/dental professionals at the local hospital where we will be working together to bring a medical mission to the people of Lalibela.

May 18th Saturday – Return to Addis Ababa Radisson Blu Hotel.

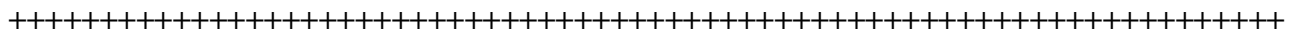
Flight leave Lalibela 10:00AM –11:10AM ADD
