



El Salvador Medical Mission

Much of El Salvador is poor in the rural area and has limited access to medical and dental care. We will focus on bringing hope and healing to the poorest of poor in El Salvador.



El Salvador may be the smallest country in Central America, but it's certainly one of its most charming. Less touristy than its neighbors, El Salvador is rich in natural beauty, pristine beaches, countless volcanoes, many Maya ruins, a great culture, and a rich history.

We will be providing 3 days of free clinic to the poor people of the Santiago Nonualco, La Paz community.

During the mission clinic days, we will be staying at a quiet Pacific Ocean beach resort with a pool, that is located on a beautiful black sand beach.

When our mission work is complete, we will adventure on a day hike to the top of the active Santa Ana Volcano, from where you can see a spectacular emerald green lake.

Last, we will spend 2 nights and have free day in the famous beach town of El Tunco, (aka Surf City), which is a popular destination for surfers from all over the world.

Friday April 12: arrive at El Salvador International Airport (SAL)

You will be picked up and transported to our hotel in Costa del Sol. Depending on what time your flight arrives, you may have time to stop at a roadside stand for some fresh coconut water or grab a traditional pupusa. Dinner and team reception for introductions and mission updates.

Saturday April 13:

Free day to unpack, take a swim, relax. “Meds” party to sort out and prepare medications and supplies for next 3 days.

After lunch, we will travel to Surf City/ El Tunco to check into our hotel and enjoy a well-deserved oceanfront sunset dinner.




Thursday April 18:
